<u>31.3 % increase in the value what has been implemented of construction</u> <u>operations in Public / public business sector companies 2014/2015</u>

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics has issued on / / 2016, the Annual Statistical Bulletin of building and construction for public / public business sector companies in 2014/2015.

The most important indicators are as follows:

- The total value of the implemented operation by public/public business sector companies reached 20.6 billion pounds in 2014/2015 versus 15.7 billion pounds for 2013/2014, an increase of 31.3%.
- The total value of implemented residential installations reached 2.4 billion pounds in 2014/2015 versus 1.1 billion pounds in 2013/2014, an increase of 127.9%.
- The total value of health installations reached 306.0 million pounds in 2014/2015 versus 154.0 million pounds in 2013/2014, an increase of 98.2%.
- The total value of educational installations reached 389.0 million pounds in 2014/2015 versus 599.0 million pounds in 2013/2014, a decrease of 35.2%.



- The total value of roads, bridges and tunnels reached 7.8 billion pounds in 2014/2015 versus 5.7 billion pounds in 2013/2014, an increase of 35.3%.
- The total value of water stations, networks reached 2.9 billion pounds in 2014/2015, versus 2.4 billion pounds in 2013/2014, an increase of 20.0%.
- The total value of implemented sewage plants and sewer systems reached 3.6 billion pounds in 2014/2015 versus 3.2 billion pounds in 2013/2014, an increase of 12.7%.



- The proportion of what has been implemented from the construction and building operations according to economic activity:
- Administrative activities and support services increased by 39.9%.
- Activity of water supply and sewage networks, management and treatment of waste by 23.1%.
- Activity of transport and storage by 15.8%.
- While the activity of food and accommodation services amounted to 0.005%, the lowest percentage in the value of what has been implemented of projects.
