

21.8 % increase in the value of the implemented operations in building and construction field by private sector companies in 2014

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics has issued on / / 2015, the Annual Statistical Bulletin of building and construction for private sector companies in 2014.

The current stable economic situation of the country for updating especially electricity and water sector infrastructure leads increase in the performance of building and construction field, especially private sector enterprises. The total value of the implemented operation by private sector companies reached 31.3 billion pounds in 2014 versus 25.7 billion pounds for 2013, an increase of 21.8%.

The most important indicators are as follows:

- The total value of residential buildings amounted to 7808 million pounds in 2014 compared to 6957 milion pounds in 2013, an increase of 12.2%
- The total value of implemented industrial premises reached 1355 million pounds in 2014 versus 1550 million pounds in 2013, a decrease of 12.6%.
- The total value of educational premises reached 215 million pounds in 2014 versus 261 million pounds in 2013, a decrease of 17.6%.



• The total value of implemented water stations and networks 569 million pounds in 2014 versus 309 million pounds in 2013, an increase of 84.1%.

- The total value of electricity stations and networks reached 1658 million pounds in 2014, versus 546 million pounds in 2013, an increase of 203.5%.
- The total value of implemented sewage plants and sewer systems reached 790 million pound in 2014 versus 1228 million pounds in 2013, a decrease of 35.7%.
