5.2 % increase in the number of university hospitals in 2013

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics, issued in / / 2014 the Annual Health services Statistical Bulletin 2013

The most important statistical indicators include:

First: the public sector:

- □ The total number of hospitals reached 632 hospital during 2013 versus 622 hospital during 2012 with an increase of 1.6 %
- The total number of universities hospitals reached 81 hospital during 2013 versus 77 hospital during 2012 an increase of 5.2%
- □ The total number of beds in hospitals reached 96062 beds during 2013 versus with 94616 beds during 2012, a decline of 1.5 %.



□ The number of aid stations reached 877 centers during 2013 versus to 843 centers during 2012, an increase of 4.0%.

Second: Public Sector Hospitals (including other ministries, hospitals):

- The total number of hospitals reached 25 hospitals during 2013 versus 24 hospitals during 2012, an increase of 4.2%.
- The total number of beds in hospitals reached
 2229 beds during 2013 versus 2204 beds
 during 2012 an increase of 1.1%.



Third: Private Sector:

- The total number of hospitals reached 937 hospital during 2013 versus 920 hospital during 2012, a decline of 1.8%.
- The total number of beds in hospitals reached
 26009 beds during 2013 versus 25447 beds
 during 2012, a decline of 2.2%.

Fourthly :Treatment at the state's expense of the state:

The total number of patients who were treated at the expense of the country abroad and at home reached1.6 million patient at the cost of 3 billion pounds during 2013 versus 1.4 million patients at a cost of 2.6 billion pounds during 2012, an increase of \Y,Y% in treatment costs.
