### 1.2 % an increase of the amount of irrigation water used in agriculture 2014

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics issued on / / 2015 The annual bulletin of irrigation and water resource that presents increase amounts of irrigation water for Agriculture , due to the increase of crop area The most important statistical indicators of the annual bulletin as follow:

-The amount of water irrigation used for Agriculture reached

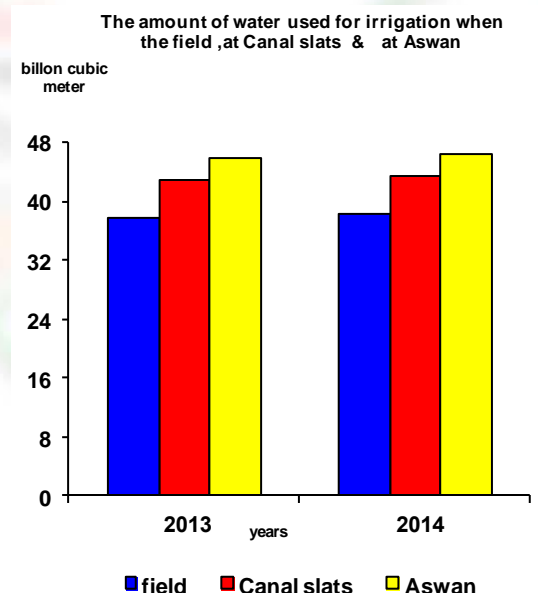
38.3 billion cubic meters in 2014 versus 37.8 billion cubic meters in 2013 Increase of 1.2%.

- The amount of water used in irrigation at Canal slats

43.6 billion cubic meter 2014 versus 43,0 Billion cubic meters in 2013, increase of 1.3 %

- The amount of water used for irrigation at Aswan

46.6 billion cubic meters in 2014 versus 46.0 billion cubic meters in 2013 increase of 1.2%.



- Winter Lug used 11.6 billion cubic meters of water which is equivalent to 30.3%, Summer lug used 23.2 billion cubic meters , Nile Lug used about 1.3 billion cubic meters of water, equivalent to 3.3% , fruit 2.2 billion cubic meters, equivalent to 5.6 % of the amount of water used in irrigation.

- The amount of water used for irrigation wells three lugs crops and fruit 21.4 thousand cubic meters in 2014 compared to 16.1 thousand cubic meters in 2013, an increase of 32.7 %.

This is due to an increase in cultivated area dependent on water wells for most crops and fruits is the three seasons.
