41.1 % increase in the amount of actual production Of vegetable oils and Industrial margarine 2013/2014

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) Issued on the // 2016 Annual Bulletin of the production, foreign trade and available for consumption movement of the most important industrial commodities in 2013/2014

The actual production and available for consumption of the most important industrial commodities:

Cement:

• The amount of cement actual production of, reached 41.8 million tons in 2013/2014 compared to 41.3 million tons in 2012/2013, an increase of 1.2 %, while the total amount of cement available for the consumption reached, 40.6 million tons in 2013/2014 compared to 39.7 million tons in 2012/2013, an increase of 2.3% due that some factories resume production after stopping as a result of workers' strikes.

Rebar:

• The amount of rebar actual production reached 6.4 million tons in 2013/2014 compared to 7.7 million tons in 2012/2013 decrease of 17.0 %While the amount of rebar available for consumption reached 6.3 million tons in 2013/2014 compared to 8.0 million tons in 2012/2013,a decrease of 21.4 % due to the increase in imports of rebar so some companies were forced to reduce its production

Fine Wheat flour:

• The amount of fine Wheat flour actual production reached 2.8 million tons in 2013/2014 compared to 3.5 million tons in 2012/2013 ,a decrease of 20.8 %. While the total amount of fine Wheat flour available for consumption reached 2.7 million tons in 2013/2014 compared to 3.4 million tons in 2012/2013

A decrease of 20.7 % due that some treadmills are working at half capacity because of decrease in cultivated area of Wheat flour and the lack of supply of wheat from some farmers due to lower supply price.

White refined sugar:

• The amount of white refined sugar actual production reached 2.0 million tons in 2013/2014 compared to 1.7 million tons in 2012/2013, an increase of 14.2% While the amount of white refined sugar available for consumption reached 1.5 million tons in 2013/2014 compared to 1.6 million tons in 2012/2013, a decrease of 1.5% due to the increase in exports .

Vegetable oils and Industrial margarine:

• The amount of vegetable oils and margarine actual production reached 1.0 million tons in 2013/2014 compared to 0.7 million tons in 2012/2013, an increase of 41.1 %. While the amount of vegetable oils and margarine available for consumption reached 1.4 million tons in 2013/2014 compared to 1.3 million tons in 2012/2013, an increase of 2.9% due to an increase in production capacity of factories.
