## Statistical Yearbook – 2016 Released

- Central Agency for public Mobilization and statistics (CAPMAS) released "Statistical Yearbook 2016" which considered a comprehensive statistical reference for all official statistics, whether economic and social statistics, produced by CAPMAS in cooperation with other ministers, authorities and all statistical stakeholders.
- The new Release covers the latest data and statistics in a time series, includes demographic, social, economic and environmental statistics, which cover education, labor force, health, cultural, tourism, external and internal trade, finance and banks, industry, agricultural, transportation and price statistics along with consumer & producer price indices, GDP, growth rates, communication statistics, National Accounts (NA), environmental statistics Egypt and governorates levels.
- This new Release includes, also, the latest data and statistics available at CAPMAS and other concerned authorities, which give a clear statistical image reflecting the changes in different State's sectors and show the differences in a simplified manner via time series of data at total and detailed levels.
- The new Release includes new data sets, the most important are NA, amount of water produced, sold and lost at governorates' levels, number of water treatment plants subordinated to water companies and amount of produced water according to its sources, the sanitation plants and their nameplate and actual capacities, beneficiaries from services supplied by subsided civil societies, distribution of insured persons according to Social Insurance Law and sectors at governorates, pensioners from former civil servants (alive and heirs), social care homes and their total residents, financial aid disbursed by the Ministry of Social Solidarity, number of beneficiaries according to type of financial aid in governorates, wholesale and retail trade in private sector, trade exchange between Egypt and most important countries.
