



12.9 % of the patents granted for Egyptians in 2019

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) issued today, / 2020, The annual Bulletin of Patents and Trademarks 2019, which aims to transfer knowledge, including patents, from technological information and making it available for scientific and technological development researchers to serve the objectives of economic and social development the Most important indicators are as follows:

* submitted Patent:

2,183 Patents submitted to Egyptian Patent
Office in 2019, including (1,027 Patents submitted for Egyptians by 47.0%, 1,156 for foreigners by 53.0%), compared to 2,255 Patents submitted in 2018 (997 for Egyptians by 44.2%, 1,258 for foreigners by 55.8%, a decrease by 3.2%



* granted Patent:

- 750 Total number of patents granted by Egyptian patent office in 2019 (175 for Egyptian, by 23.3 %, 575 patents for foreign by 76.7%) of the total, compared to 690 patents in 2018(155 patents for Egyptians by 22.5 %, 535 patents for foreigners by 77.5 %) An increase by 12.9% for Egyptian.

* granted Patent according to international classification:

-167 Number of granted patents, according to international classification in the field of chemistry and metals represents by 22.3 % of total in 2019 (33.5 % for Egyptians, 66.5 % for foreigners) followed by humanitarian needs which records 147 patents by 19.6 % (27.2% for Egyptians, 72.8 % for foreigners)

then the field of formation and transport which records 106 patents by 14.1 % (11.3 % for Egyptians 88.7 % for foreigners).- Egypt occupied first rank, as the number of granted patents from Egyptian patent office reached 175 patents representing 23.3%, followed by U.S.A, which recorded 157 patents by 20.9 % then Germany with 54 patents, 7.2 % of total number of granted patents in 2019.

*Trademarks:

- Number of applications presented from Egypt by Egyptians to obtain trademarks reached 17760 applications in 2019, compared to 21135 applications of the total in 2018 a decrease of 16.0%.
 - Total number of trademarks granted by Egyptians trademarks office reached for many countries 9010 trademarks in 2019 (Egypt 6126, other countries 2884), compared to 8729 trademarks in 2018, an increase by 3.2%.
- Egypt occupied first rank in trademarks granted by Egyptian trademarks as it reached 6126trademarks by 68% followed by U.S.A 1011 trademarks by 11.2 % then United Arab Emirates 273 trademarks by 3.0 % of the total granted trademarks in 2019.
