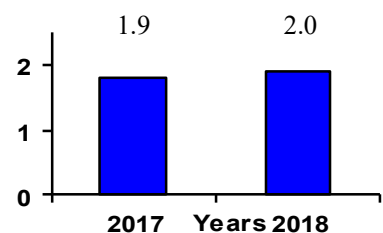
5.4 % increase in fish production in 2019

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS), issued today / / 2021 Annual Bulletin of fish production Statistics for 2019

The most important indicators are as follows:

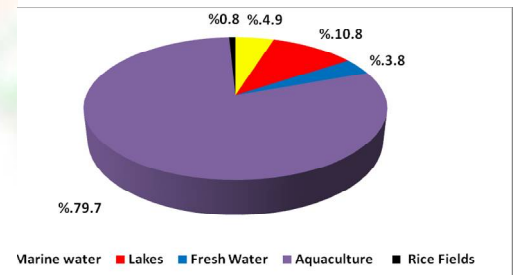
-Total Fish production reached 2.0 million ton in 2019, compared to 1.9 million tons in 2018, an increase of 5.4 % Aquaculture production came at first rank As it reached 79.7%, followed by lack fish production by 10.8%, then marine water production by 4.9%, Fresh water by 3.8% and finally rice fields by 0.8% of total fish production.

Fish Production 2018, 2019



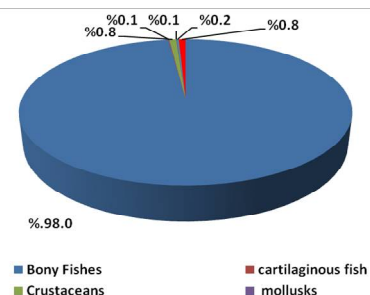
- Fish production in fish farms reached 1.62 million ton in 2019, compared to 1.54 million ton in 2018, an increase by 4.9%, compared to previous year, due to increase in number of fish farms.

Rational distribution of fish production According to fishing region 2019



- Bony fish group ranks first in Fish production (Tilapia, Buri, Denis, Seabass, Musa, coral ...) with a percentage of 98.0%, followed by other varieties and crustaceans (shrimps, crabs, ...) by 0.8% each, followed by Lungs (snails and shellfish) by 0.2%, then cartilaginous fish and Molluscs (squid) by 0.1% for each of total fish production.

Rational distribution of fish production according to fish groups 2019



-The fish production in the new national projects (for fish extraction) - Baraka Ghalioun - in Kafr El Sheikh governorate of marine fish reached 250 ton - of freshwater fish 1800 ton - and the shrimp production reached 844 ton.

-The production of seed in the fish farms with a gallon pond of seabream reached 0.2 million fry, of bean 1 Million fry, and of shrimp 250 Million fry.

-The production of shrimp in fish farms at El-Dibeh Farm - West Port Said reached 102 ton.
