70.7% decrease in number of Foot-and-mouth focus 2020

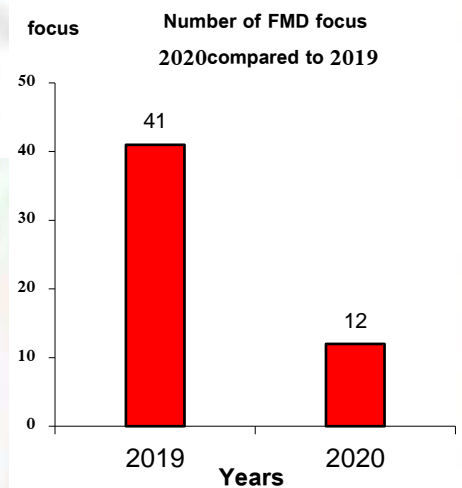
Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics issued on / / 2021 Annual bulletin of animal and poultry diseases statistics in 2020 the most important indicators are as follows:

First: cattle

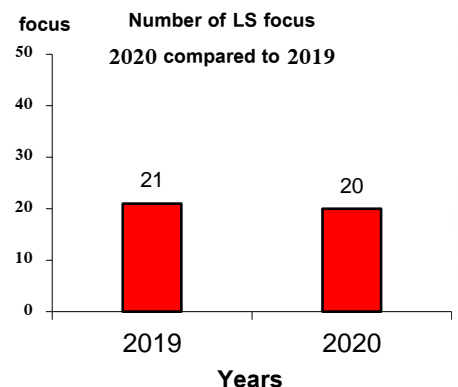
First: Livestock

1) Livestock injuries:

- Foot-and-mouth disease reached 12 focus in 2020 to 41 in 2019, a decline by 70.7% This decrease is due to the fact that the cattle did not get infected with a new strain of FMD.
- Cairo, Port Said, Qalyubia , Dakahlia , and Menia governorates recorded the highest cases of FMD 2 focus with a percentage of 16.7%, followed by Bahira and Suhag 1 focus each outbreak for governorates by 8.3%.



- Lumpy Skin diseases reached 20 focus in 2020 Compared to 21 focus in 2019, a decrease by 4.8% due to the effective of treatment methods, and Vaccines.
- Matruh Governorate recorded the highest focus With 5foci, 25.0% of the total number of foci, the lowest number of Injures in Sharkia, Kafr El-Sheikh, Menoufia Ismailia and Assiut where Only one focus was registered for each of them



2) Livestock and sheeps vaccine:

- Numbers of vaccines for the three-strain FMD vaccine for Livestock and sheeps reached 5.6 million cases in 2020 compared to 9.7 million cases in 2019, a decrease by 41.9%.
- Menoufia governorate recorded the highest number of immunizations with 723 thousand cases with a percentage by 12.8%, followed by Bahira Governorate with 567 thousand cases with a percentage of 10.0%, then Sharkia Governorate with a number of 493 thousand cases percentage of 8.7% of total number of cases Cairo Governorate recorded the least number by 9.5 thousand cases by 0.17%.

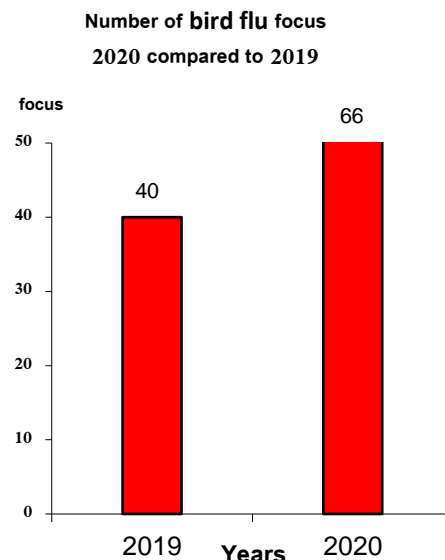
3) Treatment of livestock and animals:

- Numbers of livestock and animals treated for internal diseases reached 567 thousand case in 2020 compared to 611 thousand case in 2019, a decrease by 7.1%.
- Menoufia Governorate recorded the highest percentage, reaching 61 thousand case with a percentage of 10.8%, and the lowest is Port Said governorate, with thousand case, representing 2.0% of the total number of livestock and animals treated for internal diseases.

Second: Poultry:

1) Poultry injuries:

- Number of foci of infected poultry with bird flu is 66 focus in 2020 compared to 40 focus 2019 an increase by 65% due to efficacy of to the ineffectiveness and serum used.
- Qalyubia governorates recorded the highest incidence in bird flu, by 14 foci each with a percentage of 21.2%, followed by the governorates of Ismailia and Giza, where the number of foci in each of them reached 9 foci, with a percentage of 13.6% Followed by Dakahlia 7 each with a percentage beer of 10.6% of the total number of foci and the lowest incidence of governorates are Sharkia, Menoufia, Behera, were only one focus recorded for each.



2) Poultry Treatment:

- Number of poultry treated for internal diseases reached 2.2 million case in 2020 compared to 4.1 million cases in 2019 , a decrease by 45.6% And that as a result of infection with natural chicks to prevent diseases.

Third: Production of viral and protective vaccines:

- Number of produced viral vaccines reached 3.3 million doses in 2020 compared to 2.2 million cases in 2019, an increase by 52.6% It is due to the state's tendency to produce it locally to protect it from diseases.
