23.4% Increase in the costs of Treatment at the state's expense during 2019

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics, issued in //2020" the Annual Health services Statistical Bulletin" 2019, the most important statistical indicators are as follows:


• Treatment at the state's expense:

- The total number of patients who were treated at country expense abroad and at home reached 3.625million patients at the cost of 10.375 billion pounds during 2019, versus 2.632 million patients at a cost of 8.410 billion pounds during 2018, an increase of 23.4 % in treatment costs.


• Governmental:

- The total number of hospitals reached 652 hospitals during 2019, versus 691 hospitals during 2018, an decrease of 5.6 %.
- The total number of university hospitals reached 89hospitals during 2019, It is the same number in the previous year.
- The total number of beds in hospitals reached 92599 beds during 2019, versus 95683 beds during 2018, a decrease of 3.2 %.
- The total number of physicians reached 116314 doctors in 2019, versus 113305 doctors during 2018 a decrease of 2.7 %.

- The total number of nursing staff reached 205183 nurses in 2019 versus 196686 nurses during 2018 an increase of 4.3%.
- The total number of health insurance users reached 56.883 Million beneficiary 2019, versus 55.581 thousand beneficiary in 2018, an increase of 2.3 %.

- The number ambulance stations reached 1516 stations during 2019 versus 1464 thousand beneficiary in 2018, a decrease of 3.6 % .

• Hospitals and other bodies (including public sector hospitals):

Total number of hospitals reached 28 hospitals during 2019 It is the same number in the previous year.

- Total number of beds in hospitals reached 2761 beds during 2019 It is the same number in the previous year.

Private Sector:

- The total number of hospitals reached 1130 hospitals during 2019, versus 1157 hospitals during 2018, an decrease o f 2.3 %.
- The total number of beds in hospitals reached 35745 beds during 2019, versus 35320 beds during 2018, a increase of 1.2%.
- The total number of physicians reached 31401 doctors in 2019, versus 30733 doctors during 2018 an increase of 2.2 %.
- The total number of nursing staff reached 22269 nurses in 2019, versus 22766 nurses during 2018, an decrease of 2.2 %.
