



10.6 % Increase in the numbers of higher education graduates in 2022

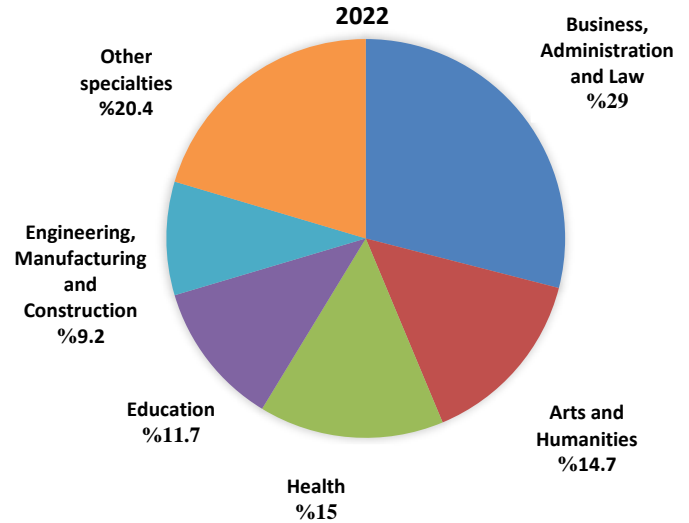

Main Indicators of Higher Education

Graduates:

- **738.1** thousand total higher education graduates in 2022, compared to **667.4** thousand graduates in 2021, an increase by **10.6%** .
- **495.6** thousand governmental universities graduates by **67.1%** of total higher education graduates in 2022.
- **48.1** thousand private universities graduates by **6.5 %** of total higher education graduates in 2022.
- **124.9** thousand private higher institutes graduates by **16.9 %** of total higher education graduates in 2022.
- **7.8** thousand academies graduates by **1.1%** of total higher education graduates in 2022.
- **61.7** thousand technical institutes graduate (governmental and private) by **8.4%** of total higher education graduates in 2022.
- **214.1** thousand graduates from Business, administration and law group by **29%** of the total higher education graduates, followed by health study group that reached **110.7** thousand graduates by **15 %**, then arts and humanities group that reached **108.5** thousand graduates by **14.7%**.
- **7906** Expatriates graduates of higher education, with a percentage of **1.1%** of higher education total graduates.

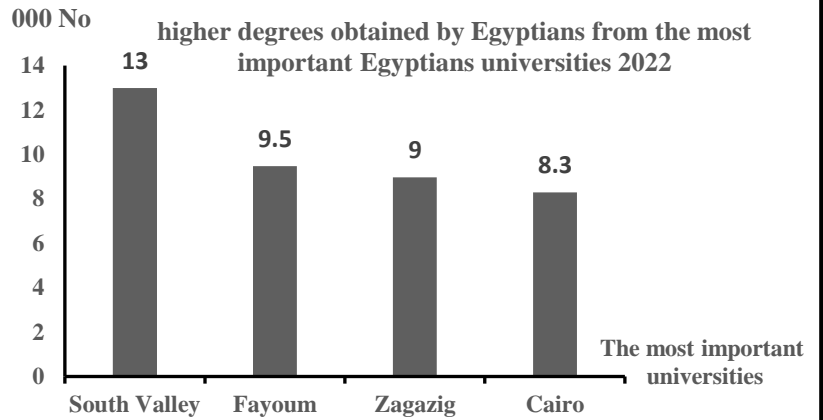

Higher Education Graduate

Degrees:

- 210.5 thousand students enrolled in higher education in Egyptian universities (46.3 % Diploma , 38.9 % Master , 14.8 % PHD) .
- 122 thousand degrees (Diploma – Master- PHD) granted to Egyptians by Egyptian universities in 2022 , compared to 110.5 thousand degrees in 2021 an increase by 10.4 % .



- Education Group comes in the first place in terms of higher degrees granted to Egyptians from Egyptian universities 2022 as of 56.4 thousand degrees by 46.2 % , followed by Business, administration and law with total number 21.7 thousand degrees by 17.8 % , then Health and well-being, of 15.2 thousand degrees by 12.5% , Services group came at last rank of 619 degrees by 0.5 % of the total degrees in 2022.
- South Valley University ranked first in the number of 13 thousand degrees by 10.6 % of the total senior Degrees granted by Egyptian universities in 2022, followed by Fayoum University as of 9.5 thousand degrees by 7.8 % and then Zagazig University, as of 9 thousand degrees by 7.4 % , followed by Cairo University, of 8.3 thousand degrees by 6.8 % .
- 4949 is the total number of arrivals of Higher Graduate Degrees in Egyptian universities in 2022 compared to 2605 arrivals in 2021, an increase by 90 % .
