




0.7% increase in fish production in 2012


Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS), issued today / 2014 Annual Bulletin of fish production Statistics for 2012.

The most important indicators are as follows:

- -Total Fish production reashed1.37 million tons in 2012 compared to 1.36 million tons in 2011. an increase of 0.7% due to the increased amount of (fish farms and rice fields) production where it came in the first place.
- Percentage of (fish farms and rice fields)
 reachea 74.2%. Followed by 12.6% lakes
 and marine waters by 8.3%, fresh water by
 4.9% of the total fish production.
- Production of a bony fish Occupies ranked first with 96.5%. Followed by other items by 1.6% and 1.2% crustaceans. Pulmonary 0.4%. Cartilaginous fish and molluscs 0.3 % of the total fish production.
