# 75.8% percentage of patents granted to Egyptians by Egyptian Patent Office in 2023

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) issued today,

/ /2024, Annual Bulletin of Patents and Trademarks of 2023, which aims to develop and encourage awareness among young researchers by shedding light on characteristics, preparation and fields of innovations, inventions and trademarks presented and granted to Egyptians and different nationalities inside Egypt according to international classification.

# Most important indicators are as follows:

## • <u>Submitted Patents:</u>

Number of Patents submitted to Egyptian Patent Office are (2101) in 2023, compared to (1914) Patents submitted in 2022 by 69.2%, an increase by 9.8% including (720) submitted Patents for Egyptians by 34.3%, (1381) for foreigners by 65.7%.

# Granted Patents:

- Number of patents granted by Egyptian patent office are (317) in 2023 compared to (512) patents in 2022, a decrease by 38.1 % of the total number of patents, including (71) for Egyptian by 22.4% and (246) patents for foreigners by 77.6 of the total patents.

## <u>Granted Patents according to international classification:</u>

- (80) Number of granted patents, according to international classification in the field of humanitarian needs represents 25.2 % of total patents in 2023 (27.5% for Egyptians, 72.5% for foreigners) followed by chemistry and metals which records (77) patents by 24.3 % (31.2% for Egyptians, 68.8 % for foreigners) then the field of Formation and transportation operations which



records (51) patents by 16.1 % (23.5% for Egyptians, 76.5% for foreigners).

#### • Granted patents for countries:

- Applicants from Egyptian ranked first, with a total of (71) patents, at a rate of 22.4% United States of America applicants came in second place, as the number of patents granted to them by the Egyptian Patent Office reached (43) patents, with a rate of 13.6%, and applicants from Germany came in third place with a total number of (28) patents, with a rate of 8.8% of the total patents granted in 2023.

#### Most important indicators are as follows:

#### **Trademarks:**

- Number of applications submitted for trademarks

reached (52853) in 2023, compared to (30423)

applications in 2022, an increase by 73.7%.

- Number of applications presented to Egyptian trademark office by Egyptians to obtain trademarks reached (47653) applications in 2023, compared to (25713) applications of total patents in 2022, an increase by 85.3%.



Number of granted trademarks reached (16659) trademarks in 2023, Egypt (12632), other countries (4027), compared to (11869) trademarks in 2022, an increase by 40.4%.

- Egypt occupied the first rank in granted trademarks by reached (12632) trademarks by 75.8% followed by U.S.A (1142) trademarks by 6.9% then U.A.E(455) trademarks by 2.7% of the total granted trademarks in 2023.
