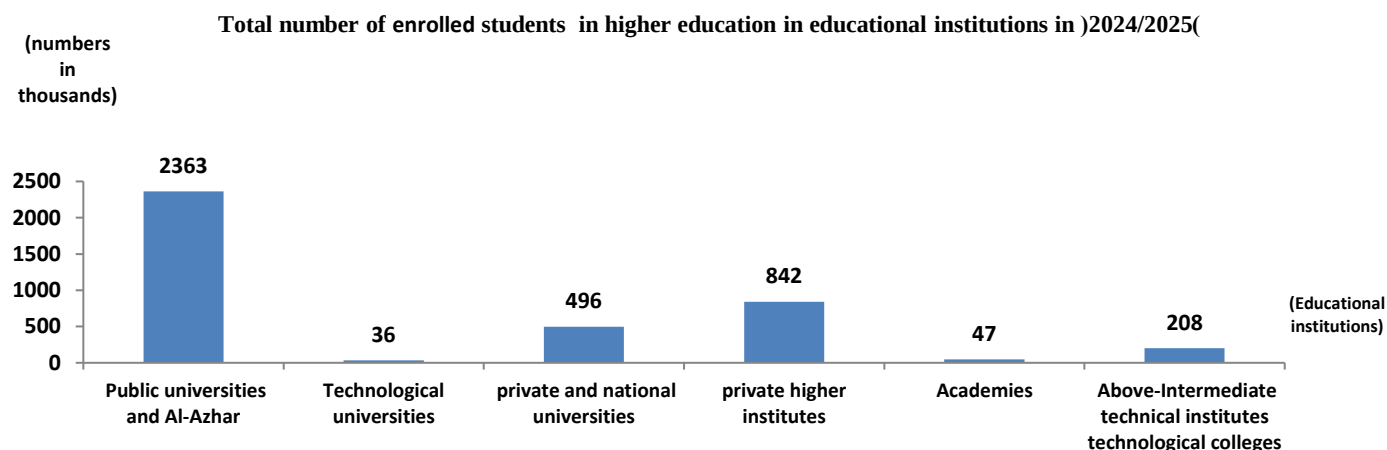

6.2% increase in the number of students enrolled in higher education in 2024/2025.

Today, / / 2025, Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics issued Annual bulletin for enrolled students and faculty members in higher education for the academic year (2024/2025)."

The most important indicators are the following:

3.9 million students enrolled in higher education for the academic year (2024/2025), compared to 3.8million students in (2023/2024), an increase by 6.2%.



Public and Al-Azhar universities:

- 2.363million students enrolled in public and Al-Azhar universities, representing 59.9% of the total higher education students in (2024/2025) compared to 2.364 million students in (2023/2024) a decrease by 0.05%.
- 28 universities containing 551 colleges, including 288 technical colleges with 1.7 million students, representing 71.1% of the total students enrolled at public universities and Al-Azhar, and 263 practical colleges with 683.6 thousand students, representing 28.9 % of the total students at public universities and Al-Azhar.
- 123.5 thousand faculty members and assistants at public and Al-Azhar universities in (2024/2025).

Technological universities:

- 35.9 thousand students enrolled in technological universities, representing 0.9% of the total higher education students in (2024/2025), compared to 20.9 thousand students in (2023/2024), an increase by 71.8%.

- Number of universities reached 10, including 17 colleges, including 2 theoretical colleges with 1003 students, representing 2.8% of the total students at technological universities, and 15 practical colleges with 34.8 thousand students, representing 97.2% of the total students at technological universities.

- 873 faculty members and assistants at technological universities in (2024/2025).

Private and national universities, foreign universities branches, and international agreements:

496.3 thousand students enrolled in private universities, representing 12.4% of the total higher education students in (2024/2025) compared to 365 thousand students in (2023/2024) an increase by 36%.

- 68 universities containing 486 colleges, including 127 theoretical colleges with 90.4 thousand students, representing 18.2% of the total private university students, and 359 practical colleges with 406 thousand students, representing 81.8% of the total private university students.

- 29.5 thousand faculty members and assistants at private universities in (2024/2025).

Private higher institutes:

- 172 higher institutes 841.7 thousand students enrolled in private higher institutes, representing 21.1% of the total higher education students. in (2024/2025), compared to 775.7 thousand students in (2023/2024), an increase by 8.5%.

- 7.7 thousand faculty members in private higher institutes in (2024/2025).

Academies:

- 4 Academies 47.4 thousand students enrolled in academies, representing 1.2% of the total higher education students in (2024/2025), compared to 35.3 thousand students in (2023/2024) a decrease by 34.2 %.

- 2.5 thousand faculty members in academies in (2024/2025).

Above-intermediate technical institutes and technological colleges (government/private):

- 207.7 thousand students enrolled in government and private upper-medium technical institutes, representing 5.2% of the total higher education students in (2024/2025) compared to 199.6 thousand students in (2023/2024) an increase by 4.1%.

- 2.1 thousand faculty members in government and private upper-medium technical institutes in (2024/2025).

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
