

50% of deaths in car accidents of youth in 2013

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics issued

Today / /2014, the Annual Bulletin of car and trains accidents in 2013 the most important indicators are as follows:

- The highest proportion of deaths in car accidents 50% of the age group (15-25) at a rate of 13.3 per 100 000 youth in 2013
- The total number of car accidents reached 15578 accident in 2013 compared to 15516 accident in 2012, an increase of 0.4%, and the number of trains accidents reached 781 accidents in



2013 compared to 447 accidents in 2012, an increase of 74.7 % This is due to the poor state of part gates (barriers).

- The largest number of cars accidents according to month level reached 1350 incident, in December it reached 8.7 %, and the lowest number was 1240 incident in January, it reached 8.0% of the total accidents in the governorates and highways in 2013.
- The largest number of accidents at the governorate in shakia governorate level reached 1144 accidents 8.3% and less governorate was all wady all gadid it reached 157 accident by 1.1 % in 2013.
- The rate of one dead person/ day reached 18.4 dead due to car accidents in 2013 versus 17.6 dead /day in 2012 .
- The rate of dead person / 100 000 vehicles in 2013 reached 95.2 dead versus 97.3 dead in 2012 .

- The rate of one injured person / day reached 61.4 injured in 2013 compared to 59.2 injured in 2012 .
- The highest rate of accidents/ 1000 vehicles reached 20.2 in South Sinai Governorate, while the lowest rate of accidents reached 0.4 / 1000 vehicles in Cairo in 2013 .
- The accident seriousness rate in Governorate reached 1.8 deceased or injured/accident in 2013 compared to 1.7 dead or injured / accident in 2012.
- The accident seriousness rate on highways reached 2.5 dead or injured / accident in 2013, and the highest rate of seriousness was 5.7 on the Helwan / Coraimat road, and the lower rate was 1.5 to 1 m on the Ring Road.
- The rate of accidents was one accident / 100 km in Port Said Governorate reached 43.0 accident, then 40.9 / 100 km accident in Monoufia Governorate in 2013.
- The human element was the most common reasons for accidents where it reached in 2013 65.2 % of total causes of accidents, followed by Technical case 18.3 % of the car
- The number of trains accidents reached 781 accident in 2013 versus 447 in 2012 increase of 74.7%
- •The collision of trains gateway ports (barriers) are the largest number of train accidents cases at the regional level it reaching 431 by 55.2% of the total train accidents in 2013
- The largest number of train accidents reached 119 incidents in June and the lowest number in October, reached 32 accident in 2013.
- The rate of train accidents reached 4.4 / million passengers in 2013 compared to 1.9 accidents / million passengers in 2012.
