17.9 % Drop in the value of the implemented operations in building and construction field by private sector companies in 2012

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics has issued on / /2013, the Annual Statistical Bulletin of building and construction for private sector companies in 2012.

The current unstable economic situation of the country leads to a decline in the performance of building and construction field, especially private sector enterprises. The total value of the implemented operation by private sector companies reached 23.22 million pounds in 2012 versus 28.27 million pounds for 2011, a decrease of 17.9%.

The most important indicators are as follows:

- The total value of implemented industrial premises reached 1476 million pounds in 2012 versus 1225 million pounds in 2011, an increase of 20.5%.
- The total value of health buildings reached 168 million pounds in 2012 versus 164 million pounds in 2011, an increase of 15.1%.
- The total value of educational premises reached 281 million pounds in 2012 versus 321 million pounds in 2011, a decrease of 12.3%.
- The total value of implemented water stations and networks by private sector companies reached 535 million pounds in 2012 versus 248 million pounds in 2011, an increase of 116.2%.
- The total value of electricity stations and networks reached 530 million pounds in 2012, versus 1867 million pounds in 2011, a decrease of 71.6%.
- The total value of implemented sewage plants and sewer systems reached 1434 million pounds in 2012 versus 1782 million pounds in 2011, a decrease of 19.5%.
