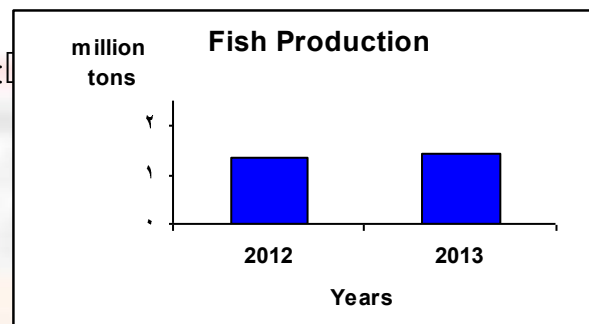

### 0.7 % increase in fish production in 2013

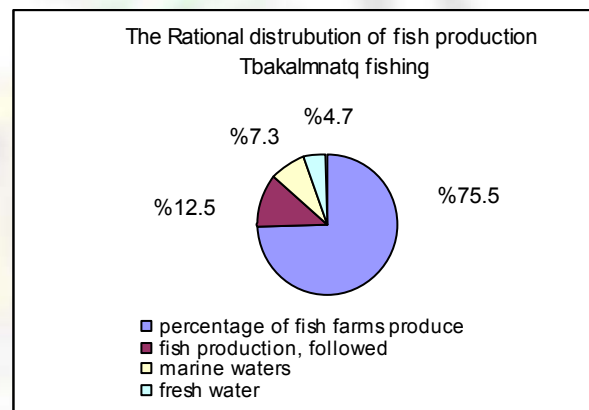
Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS), issued today / / 2014 Annual Bulletin of fish production Statistics for 2013.

The most important indicators are as follows:

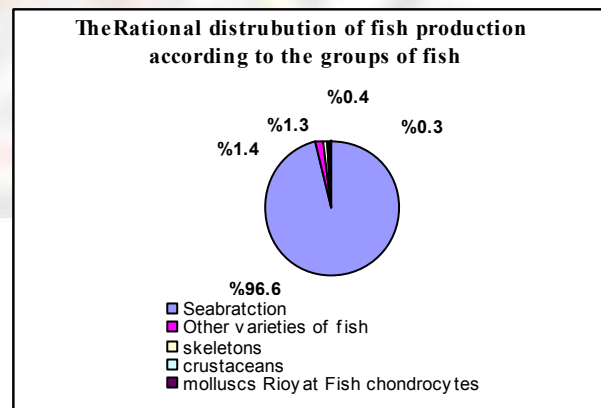
- Total Fish production reached 1.45 million tons in 2013 compared to 1.37 million tons in 2012, an increase of 6.0% due to the increased amount of (fish farms and rice fields) production where it came in the first place.



- Percentage of (fish farms and rice fields) reached 75.5%. Followed by 12.5% lakes and marine waters by 7.3%, fresh water by 4.7% of the total fish production.



- Production of a bony fish occupies ranked first with 96.6%. Followed by crustaceans by 1.4%, and other items by 1.3% and Pulmonary 0.4%. Cartilaginous fish and molluscs 0.3% of the total fish production.
