8.3% decrease in the number of foreigners working in private and investment sector in Egypt 2014

CAPMAS issued on / / " The Annual bulletin of Foreigners working in private and investment sectors in Egypt 2014 "The most important statistical indicators are as follow:

- The total number of foreigners working in the private and investment sectors reached 13486 foreigners from different nationalities in 2014 compared to 14699 foreigners in 2013, a decrease of 8.3%. The number of Foreigners working in Egpt, for The first time, reached 4372 foreigner, a percentage of 32.4% and the re.contracted foreigners reached 9114 foreigners,a percentage of 67.6% in 2014 .

30.5% working foregners from Arab countries

- Foreign arrivals, from Arab countries represent the largest number which reached 4111 foreigners by 30.5%, followed by European countries that reached 4090 foreigners by 30.3%, then Asian countries that reached 3934 foreigners by 29.2%. while African countries (non Arabic) represent the lowest number that reached 141 foreigners by 1% of the total number of foreigners working in the private and investment sectors in 2014.

26.9% of foreigner legislators, senior officials and managers

- Legislators, senior officials and managers came in the first rank in terms of number of foreigners employees in these professions which reached 3631 foreigner by 26.9%, followed by foreign technicians and speialist assistances
- that reached 3292 foreigners by 24.4%, then crafts and reiated trades workers that reached 2088 foreigners by 15.5%,then professionals that

reached 1712 foreigners by 12.7% of the total number of foreigners working in private and investment sectors in 2014.

18.3% percentage of Palestinians working in private and investment sectors

- Palestine came in the first rank in terms of number of foreigners working in private and investment sectors which reached 2463 foreigners by 18.3%, followed by Bangladesh which reached 1226 foreigners by 9.1%, then India which reached 1069 foreigners by 7.9%, then England which reached 772 foreigners by 5.7% of the total number of foreigners working in private and investment sectors in 2014.

45.7% working licenses issued by the labour force Directorates

- The labour force Directorates represents the first rank in terms of issued working licenses, where the number of issued working licenses reached 6160 licenses by 45.7%, followed by investment offices which reached 4744 licenses by 35.2%, then corporate office which reached 1353 licenses by 10%, then petroleum offices which reached 1229 licenses by 9.1% of the total number of licenses issued foreigners working in private and investment sectors in 2014.
