


<u>11% Increase in number of Students in training institutions</u> (governmental sector) 2016/2017

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics, issued today / / 2018 "Annual Bulletin for Education and training Statistics in training institutions in Governmental and private sectors 2016/2017," which aims to monitor types of training in governmental and private sectors in order to develop human skills and gain additional expertise in multiple disciplines.



The most important indicators are as follows :

First: Training institutions in governmental and private sectors

- 601 total number of training institutions in 2016/2017 compared to 613 institutions in 2015/2016 a decline of 2 %.

Cairo governorate, represents the largest number as it reached 114 institutions, followed by Kaliobeya 42 institutions.

Governmental sector

• 483 the total number of training institutions in 2016/2017(formal & non formal), compared to 485 institutions in 2015/2016, a decline of 0.4%. Cairo Governorate took first place ,reaching 104 institutions by 21.5%.

• 185 Nursing training institutions occupied the first place by 38.3% of the total number of training institutions (formal & non formal) .

private sector

• 118 is number of vocational training centers in the Ministry of Social Solidarity training institutions in 2016/2017, compared 128 centers in 2015/2016, a decline of 7.8 %.

• Assiut occupied the first place in terms of number of centers which reached 14 centers by 11.9%, whereas the lowest number of centers are at Sharkia, Gharbia, Behera ,Luxor as there is only one center by 0.8%.

Second: Students in training institutions

76853 students in formal education in governmental sector training institutions in 2016/2017, compared to 69249 students in 2015/2016, an increase of 11%.
8229 students in vocational training centers (private sector) in 2016/2017, compared to 8816 students

(in 2015/2016, a decrease by 6.7% (formal & non formal

Third: Graduates of training institutions

• 24502 graduates of formal education (government sector) in 2016/2017, compared to 22219 graduates in 2015/2016, an increase of 10.3%.

• 5697 graduates in vocational training centers (private sector) in 2017/2016, compared to 6694 graduates in 2015/2016, a decrease by 14.9% (formal & non formal).
