



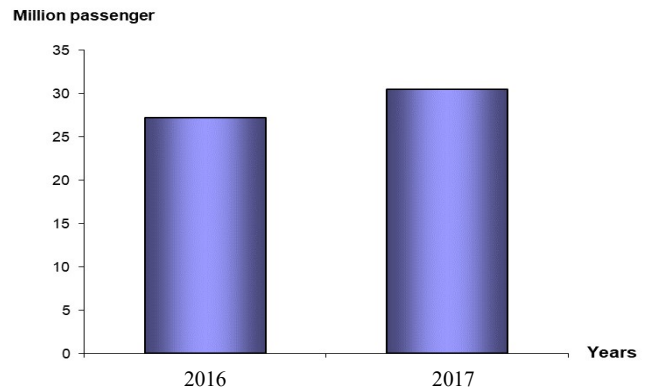
## 12.1% increase in number of passengers at airports in 2017

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) issued in // 2019 " Annual Bulletin of air transport statistics for 2017" ,The most important indicators are as follows:

### Overall movement of Airports:

- Total passenger traffic for airports reached 30.5 million passengers in 2017 compared to 27.2 million passengers in 2016, with an increase by 12.1%.
- Total number of flights to airports reached to 281.0 thousand trips in 2017, compared to 276.7 thousand trips in 2016, with an increase by 1.5%
- Total quantity of transported goods was 320.7 thousand tons in 2017 compared 338.2 thousand tons in 2016 , a decrease of 5.2%.

### Overall movement of airports at national companies:

- Total international and domestic passenger traffic was 15.72 million passengers in 2017, compared to 15.71 million passengers in 2016, with an increase by 0.1% (including 10.7 million passengers for international traffic by 68.2%, local traffic 5.0 million passengers by 31.8%) Passenger traffic for national companies was 51.5% of total passenger traffic for air ports .
- Total international and domestic traffic of passenger and cargo aircraft at airports was 217.5 thousand trips in 2017, compared to 225.1 thousand in 2016, with a decrease of 3.4% (including 134.3 thousand trips by international movement by 61.7%, domestic traffic 83.3 thousand trips by 38.3% ) the Ratio of national companies flights was 77.4% of total airport traffic.
- Quantity of transported goods was 142.8 thousand tons in 2017, compared to 134.5 thousand tons in 2016, with an increase by 6.2% (including 80.8 thousand tons exported by 56.6%, 37.6 thousand tons imported by 26.4% , 24.3 thousand tons transit by 17.0 %) And the ratio of goods movement for national companies was 44.5% of the total movement of goods to air ports .

- The number of Egyptian airports in which the national airlines movement has been conducted , has reached 20 airports.
- The number of national airlines was 20 companies, including 10 companies in public business sector, 10 private sector companies.
- Number of aircrafts used in national companies was 189 aircrafts (including 89 were owned by 47.1% and 100 were rented by 52.9%).
- Total number of national airlines employees was 36891 workers in 2017, compared to 37034 workers in 2016 with a decrease of 0.4%.
- Total value of cash wages, in kind benefits and social insurance for national airlines was 4.3 billion pounds in 2017, compared to 3.4 billion pounds in 2016, with an increase of 25.1%.
