

13.1 % in the governmental sector in 2018


Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) and the ministry of Manpower issued today // 2019 the "Annual Bulletin of labor injury statistics in governmental public / public business, private and investment sectors (50 workers more) in 2018", the most important statistical indicators are as follows:

• Total number of labor injury cases reached 14368 cases in 2018compared to 13541 case in 2017 by an increase of 827 case 6.1%.



42 % injuries in public / public business sectors in 2018

• Number of labor injury cases in governmental sector reached 1878 cases by 13.1%, in public sector / public business sector reached 6033 cases by 42%, in private sector (50 workers and more) reached 5978 cases which represent 41.6%, and investment sector reached 479 cases by 3.3% out of total number of cases.



Percent distribution of work

91.9 % labor male injuries in 2018

The number of work injury cases reached 13199 cases by 91.9 % for males, while it reached for females 1169 cases by 8.1 % of the total number of cases.

26.7 % Injuries in Cairo governorate in 2018

Cairo Governorate recorded the largest number of labor injury cases which reached 3834case by 26.7%, followed by Giza Governorate which reached 2504 case by 17.4%, while El-Wadi El-Gidid Governorate recorded the lowest number of labor injury cases which reached 6 cases by 0.04% out total number of cases.

40.7 % Technicians and specialist assistants injuries in 2018

Technicians and specialist assistants recorded the largest number of labor injury cases. It reached 5852 cases by 40.7%, followed by craft and related trades workers which reached 2379 cases that represents 16.6 %, while the lowest number of work injury cases was for farmers, agricultural and fishery workers that reached 86 cases by 0.6 % out total number of cases.

60.1 % Injuries in manufacturing activity in 2018

Manufacturing activity recorded the largest number of labor injury cases as it reached 8631 cases by 60.1%, followed by transportation, storage and telecommunications activity which reached 1358 cases by 9.5 %, while the lowest number of labor injury cases was in insurance, financial brokery which reached 5 cases by 0.03%.

28.3 % Injuries by a Fall down

The highest number of labor injury cases by a Fall down as it reached 4059 cases by 28.3 %, followed by mistakes or crashing reached 4003 cases by 27.9 %, while the lowest number of work injury cases was in accidents of explosion which reached 31 cases by 0.2% out of the total number of cases .
