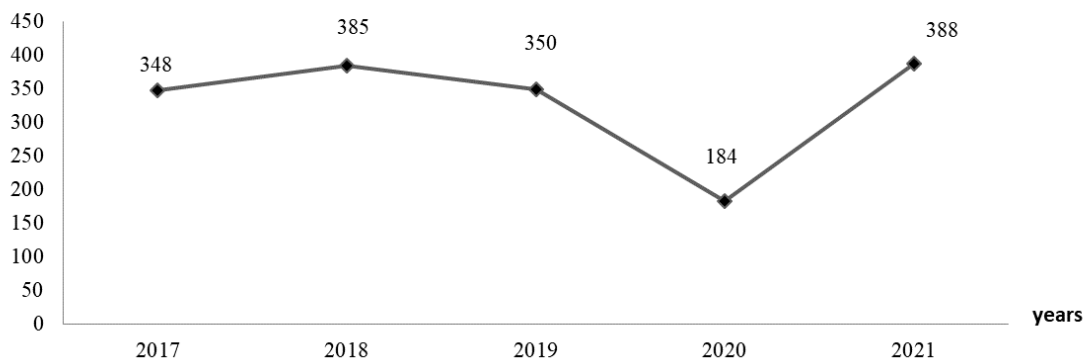

### Number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status increase from 184 emigrant 2020 to 388 emigrant 2021

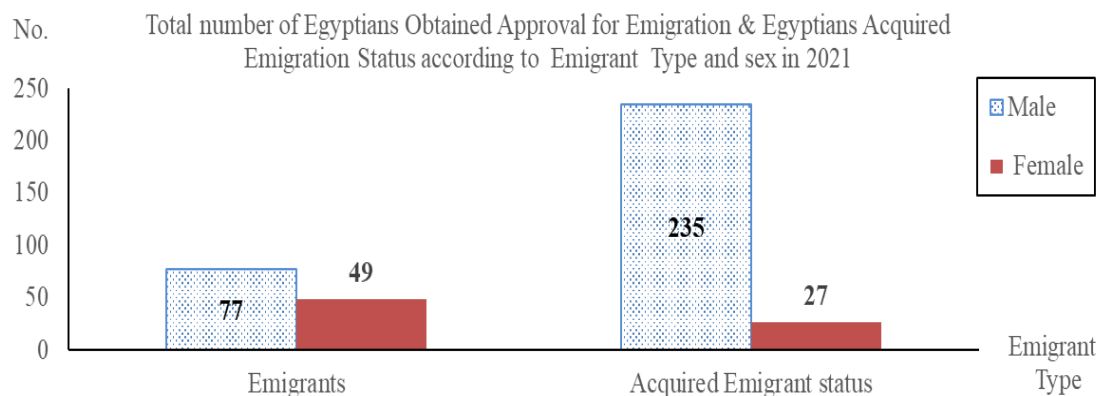
Central agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics issued today: / / 2022 “Annual Bulletin of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired another Nationality 2021”. The most important statistical indicators are as follows:

- Total number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status reached 388 emigrant in 2021 (126 emigrant and 262 Acquired Emigration Status), compared to 184 emigrant in 2020, with an increase of 110.9%, due to decrease of the Covid 19 pandemic (Corona).

Development of Egyptians Received a Permission to Emigrate Abroad and those who acquired Emigrant features (2017-2021)



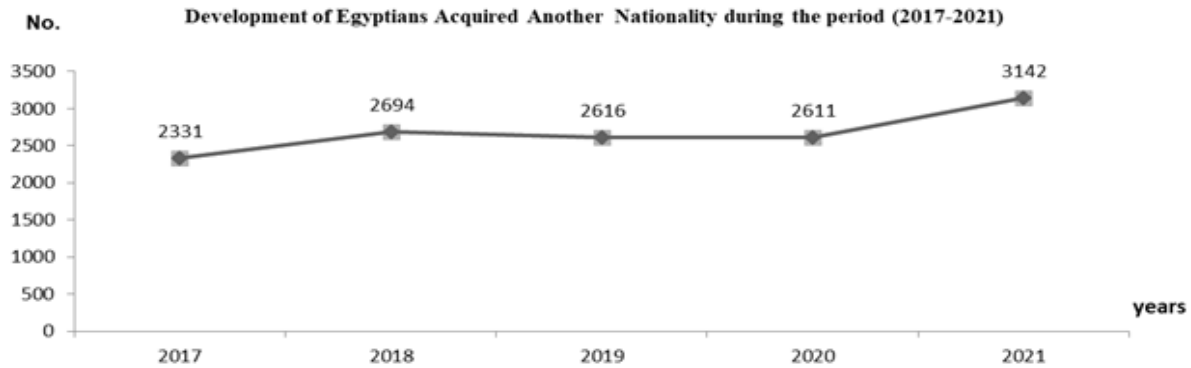
- Total Number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status reached 388 (292 originally emigrant by 75.3%, and 96 companied emigrant by 24.7%) in 2021.
- Number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status of male reached 312 male emigrant by 80.4% (77 Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration by 19.8% & 235 Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status by 60.6%) and 76 female emigrant by 19.6% of the total number of emigrant (49 Female Obtained Approval for Emigration by 12.6% & 27 Female Acquired Emigration Status by 7%).



**USA rated the first in number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status by 40% in 2021**

- USA rated the first in regards to the number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status in 2021, with 155 emigrants by 40%, followed by Italy with 125 emigrant by 32.2%, Then Canada with 89 migrants, 23% of the total number of emigrants.
- The age group (40 - 44 years) came first in terms of the number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status reached 83 migrant by 21.4% of the total number of emigrants.
- Married couples category occupied the largest share of number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status, with 261 emigrants by 83.9% of total emigrants at marriage age (18 years and over for males and females).
- Private Sector occupied the largest share of number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status with 261 Emigrant by 70.2%, followed by Emigrants who did not work such as housewives, Fresh graduates and full-time students (other's) with 102 emigrant by 27.4% of total emigrants at work age ( 6 years and more)
- The category of Professionals has the largest share of number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status reached 120 emigrants by 35.8%, followed by the category of Elementary occupations reaching 81 migrants with 24.2% of the total number of emigrant (15 years and above).
- Emigrants with university degree ranked the first in terms of number of Egyptians Obtained Approval for Emigration & Egyptians Acquired Emigration Status reached 137 emigrant by 38.2% of total emigrants at education age (10 years and over).

**20.3% an increase of Egyptians who acquired foreign nationalities in 2021.**



- Number of Egyptians who acquired foreign nationalities reached 3142 Egyptians in 2021, compared to 2611 Egyptians in 2020 with an increase of 20.3% of (1779 Egyptians obtained naturalization permission while retaining the Egyptian citizenship by 56.6% and 1363 Egyptians who obtained naturalization permission while not retaining the Egyptian nationality by 43.4%).
