
#### 14,8%Decrease in deactivated energy value 2013/2014

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) has issued on / / 2015 the Annual Statistical Bulletin of The actual production, deactivated energy and inventory of full production at industrial activities level, in the public sector / public business (sector establishment) 201 3/2014.

#### The most important indicators are as follows:


#### Actual production

- The total value of actual production reached 128,8 billion pounds in 2013/2014compared to 122,4 billion pounds in 2012/2013, an increase of 5,3%.
- Coke and petroleum products as the highest percentage reached 65,3 % followed by the food industry by 11,3% of the total.



#### Deactivated energy

- •The total value of deactivated energy reached 6,7 billion pounds in 2013/2014 compared to 7,9 billion pounds in 2012/2013, a decrease of 14,8% the reason for this is the beginning of stability in industrial facilities.
  - the textile industry contributed the highest percentage reaching 41.9% of the total followed by the textile industry by 26.1% of the total.



# <u>Inventory of last year full</u> production

- The total value inventory of last year full reached production 5.5 billion pounds in 2012/2013, compared to 6.1 billion pounds in 2011/2012 a decrease of 10.1%
- Food products industry contributed the highest percentage reaching 26.2% followed by industry of basic metals by 20.6% of the total.
