27.1 % increase in the value of the implemented operations in building and construction field by private sector companies 2015


Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics has issued on / / 2016, the Annual Statistical Bulletin of building and construction for private sector companies 2015.

The most important indicators are as follows:

The value of what has been implemented of operations in building and construction sector companies of private sector increased to 39.8 billion pounds in 2015 compared to 31.3 billion pounds in 2014, an increase of 27.1 % which is due to be updated infrastructure, especially in the

electricity, sewage plants and educational premises.

- The total value of residential buildings reached 8.9 billion pounds in 2015 compared to 7.8 billion pounds in 2014, an increase of 14.5%
- The total value of implemented industrial premises reached 1.3 billion pounds in 2015 versus 1.4billion pounds in 2014, a decrease of 0.9%.
- The total value of educational premises reached 933 million pounds in 2015 versus 215 million pounds in 2014, an increase of 334.1%.
- The total value of implemented water stations and networks reached 648 million pounds in 2015 versus 569 million pounds in 2014, an increase of 13.9%.
- The total value of electricity stations and networks reached 5.5 billion pounds in 2015, versus 1.7 billion pounds in 2014, an increase of 231.2%.
- The total value of implemented sewage plants and sewer systems reached 1.8 billion pound in 2015 versus 0.8 billion pounds in 2014, an increase of 134.1%.
