

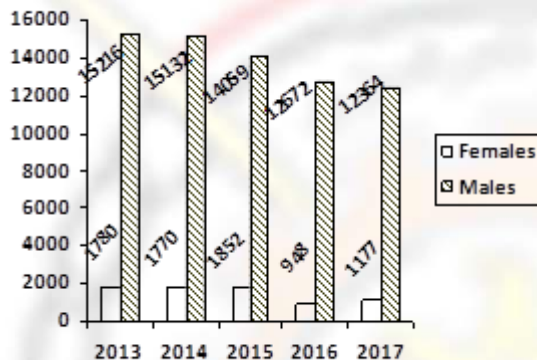

Injuries in the governmental sector reached 13.3 % in 2017

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) issued today 24 / 9 / 2018 the "Annual Bulletin of labor injury statistics in the governmental sector investment sector, public / public business , private sectors and (50 workers more) in 2017", the most important statistical indicators are as follows:

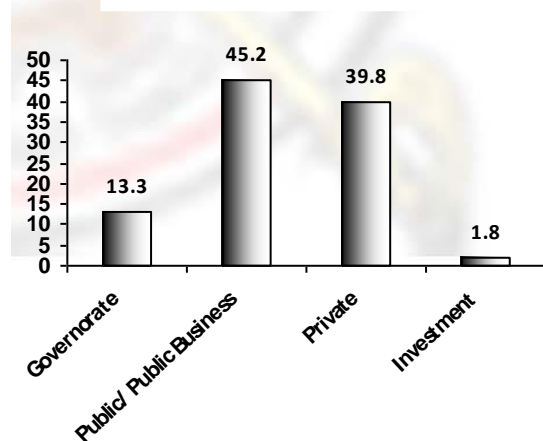


- The total number of labor injury cases reached 13541 cases in 2017 compared to 13620 cases in 2016 with a decrease by 79 cases 0.6%.

Injuries in public and public business sectors reached 45.2 % in 2017

- The number of labor injury cases in governmental sector reached 1795 cases by 13.3%, in public sector / public business reached 6118 cases by 45.2%, in private sector (50 workers and more) reached 5389 cases which represent 39.8%, and investment sector reached 239 cases by 1.8 % out of the total number of cases.

The percent distribution of work injuries according to the sector in 2017



Work injuries for males reached 91.3 %

The number of work injury cases reached 12364 cases by 91.3 % for males, while it reached for females 1177 cases by 8.7 % of the total number of cases.

Injuries in Cairo governorate reached 30.9 %

Cairo Governorate recorded the largest number of labor injury cases which reached 4181 case by 30.9%, followed by Alexandria Governorate which reached 2074 case by 15.3%, while El-Wadi El- Gidid Governorate recorded the lowest number of labor injury cases which reached 13 cases by 0.1 % out the total number of cases.

Technicians and specialist assistants reached 31.6 Injuries for

Technicians and specialist assistants recorded the largest number of labor injury cases. It reached 4281 cases by 31.6%, followed by craft and related trades workers which reached 2524 cases that represent 18.6 %, while the lowest number of work injury cases was for farmers, agricultural and fishery workers that reached 62 cases by 0.5 % out the total number of cases.

Injuries in manufacturing activity reached 60.3 %

Manufacturing activity recorded the largest number of labor injury cases as it reached 8171 cases by 60.3%, followed by transportation, storage and telecommunications activity which reached 1641 cases by 12.1 %, while the lowest number of labor injury cases was in the insurance, financial broker which reached 2 cases.

Injuries after a fall down reached 33.3 %

The highest number of labor injury cases of a fall down it reached 4511 cases by 33.3 %, followed by mistakes or crashing reached 3596 cases by 26.6 %, while the lowest number of work injury cases was in incidents of explosion which reached 12 cases by 0.01% out of the total number of cases.
