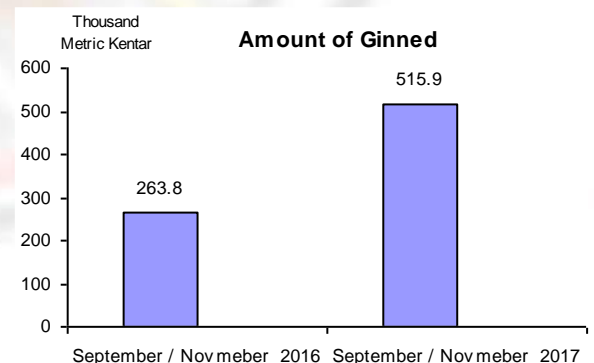
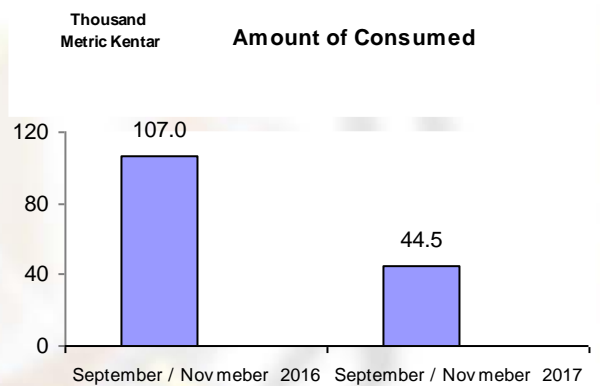
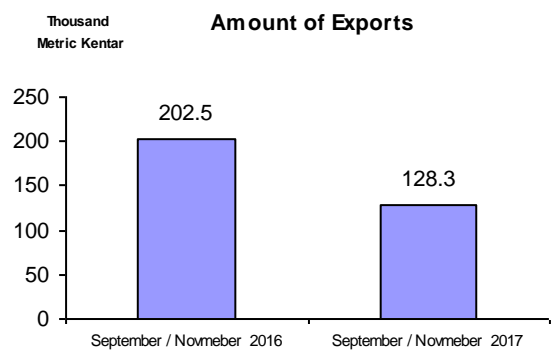

36.7% increasing of the Egyptian cotton exports in the first quarter of the agricultural season 2017/ 2018

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) issued in / / 2018 the quarterly bulletin of cotton for first quarter (September/ November 2017) for the agricultural season 2017/2018.

The most important indicators are as follows:

- The total amount of Egyptian cotton exports reached 128.3 thousand metric Kentar during (September/ November 2017) compared to 202.5 thousand metric Kentar during the same period of the previous season, a decline of 36.7% This decrease is due to the decrease in cotton cultivated area in the previous season
- The total amount of domestic consumed cotton reached 44.5 thousand metric Kentar during (September/November 2017) compared to 107.0 thousand metric Kentar at the same period of the previous season, a decline of 58.4% due that some of spinning factories stopped working.
- The amount of ginned cotton reached 515.9 thousand metric kentar during (September/ November 2017) compared to 263.8 thousand metric Kentar at the same period of the previous season, a decline of 95.5% This increase is due to the accumulation of the crop from the previous season.□
