9.3% decrease in the number of Road accident injuries in 2021

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics issued today

\ \ 2022 "Annual bulletin results of car and train accidents in 2021."
the most important indicators were the following:

First: The results of car accidents:

- Number of road accident injuries reached 51511 in 2021 compared to 56789 in 2020, a decrease by 9.3%.
- Highest number of injuries at governorates level is in Dakahlia , where it reached 11630 injuries, and the lowest number of injuries is in Luxor, where it reached 102 injuries in 2021.
- July is the highest month of the year in terms of road accident injuries, reaching 4918 injuries, while December is the lowest month, reaching 3710 injuries in 2021.
- Number of deceased reached 7101 in 2021, compared to 6164 in 2020, an increase by 15.2%.
- Number of male injuries reached 41670 in 2021 compared to 46324 in 2020 a decrease by 10%, while the number of female injuries reached 9331 in 2021 compared to 10222 in 2020 a decrease by 8.7%.
- For age groups, the highest number of injured people was in the age category (-15 years) with 14703 injured, followed by the category (-25 years) with 10134 injured people , followed by the category (-35 years) with 7156 injured, while the lowest number was in the category (+65 years) with a number of 1178 injured people in 2021.

- Road accident injuries by road user (passengers) ranked first with 17805, followed by (pedestrians) with 12948 injured in 2021.
- Rate of severity (number of deaths per 100 injured) reached 13.8 in 2021 compared to 10.9 in 2020, an increase by 26.6%.
- Death rate per 100000 people reached 7.0 in 2021 ,compared to 6.2 in 2020 with a increase of 12.9%.
- Death rate per 100000 vehicles reached 65.1 in 2021, compared to 57.1 in 2020, an increase by 14%.
- Injured rate per 100.000 people reached 50.5 in 2021 ,compared to 56.4 in 2020, a decrease by 10.5%.
- Rate of injured/100 thousand vehicles reached 472.6 in 2021 compared to 525.8 in 2020, a decrease of 10.1%.

Second: The results of train accidents:

- Number of train accidents reached 978 in 2021 compared to 898 in 2020, a increase by 8.9%.
- Highest number of train accidents at regional level was in (Central Delta and central) region, with 243 accidents, at a rate of 24.8%, and the lowest number in the (Southern) region was 82accidents at a rate of 8.4%.
- Number of decease in train accidents reached 405 in 2021, compared to 296 in 2020, an increase by 36.8%.
- Number of injured people reached 769 in 2021 compared to 525 in 2020, an increase by 46.5%.
- Train accidents according to liability (responsibility of third parties) are the highest cause of train accidents, reaching 693 accidents, by 70.9% in 2021.
- Average train accident in 2021 for estimated population in the middle of the year was 0.10 (accident / 10,000 people) while the accident rate for the number of train passengers was 3.9 (accident / million passengers).
- Rate of severity of train accidents (52.7dead / 100 injured) in 2021, while it was 56.4 who died in 2020.
