### 3.7 % An increase in the number of pre-university Pupils for the academic year 2021 / 2022

Central Agency for public Mobilization and statistics (CAPMAS) issued today / 12 /2022 "Annual Bulletin of pre –university education for the academic year 2021/2022 "

#### Main indicators include:

#### Pre-primary:

- 1.3 Million Pupils by 4.9 % of total educational stages (1.2 Million Pupils by 4.7 % at education, 162.1 thousand Pupils by 7.3 % at Azhar education) of all total education stage in 2021/2022.
- 63.4 thousand teachers (59.5 thousand teachers by 6.0 % at general education, 4.9 thousand teachers by 2.6 % at Azhar education) of total educational stages in 2021/2022.
- 12.7 thousand schools, 1.7 thousand Azhar institute education for the academic year 2021/2022.

#### Primary:

- 14.9 Million Pupils at general by 54.6 % of total education stages (13.7 Million Pupils by 54.6 % at education, 1.2 Million Pupils by 55.0 % Azhar Education) of total educational stages in 2021/2022.
- 503.4 thousand teachers by 433.5 thousand teachers at general education by 43.7 % ,69.9 thousand teachers by 46.4 % Azhar Education) of total educational stages in 2021/2022.
- 19.6 thousand schools, 3.7 thousand Azhar institutes 2021/2022.
- 0.2% of primary school dropout rate in 2020/2021 compared to 0.2% in 2019/2020.
- 98.1% transition rate from primary to middle school in 2021/2022.

#### **Community education:**

- 140.2 thousand Pupils at (one class) by 0.5 % of total educational stages in 2021/2022.
- 7.8 thousand teachers by 0.8 % of total educational stages in 2021/2022.
- 4.9 thousand schools (one class) of education for 2021 / 2022 there is no community education at Al-Azhar.

#### Preparatory:

- 6.3 Million Pupils by 23.0 % (5.8 Million Pupils by 23.3 % at general education, 442.2 thousand Pupils by 20.0 % at Azhar Education) of total educational stages in 2021/2022
- 286.2 thousand teachers 246.6 thousand teachers at general education by 24.8%, 39.8 thousand teachers by 26.4 % at Azhar Education) of total educational stages in 2021/2022.
- 13.3 thousand schools 3.5 thousand Azhar institutes in 2021/2022.

- 0.9 % dropout rate in primary school 2020/2021, compared to 1.7% in 2019/2020
- 39.4 % Rate of transition from primary to preparatory stage in 2021/2022.

#### Secondary:

- 2.4 Million Pupils by 8.8 % of total educational stages (2 Million Pupils by 8.0 % at education, 381.5 thousand Pupils by 17.2 % at Azhar Education) of total educational stages in 2021/2022.
- 136.1 thousand teachers (99.7 thousand teachers at education by 10.0%, 36.4 thousand teachers by 24.1% at Azhar Education) of total educational stages 2021/2022.
- 4.3 thousand schools at general, 2.3 thousand Azhar institutes in 2021/2022.

#### **Technical Secondary:**

- 2.2 Million Pupils by 8.0% of total educational stage (1.0 Million Pupils by 46.7 % Industrial education, 904.9 thousand Pupils by 41.3 % commercial education (General/hotel), 262.0 thousand Pupils by 12.0 % Agricultural education) of total technical secondary education in 2021/2022.
- 135.3 thousand teachers (86.3 thousand teachers at industrial education by 63.8%, 37.7 thousand teachers at commercial education by 27.9 %, 11.2 thousand teachers at agricultural education by 8.3%) of total technical education teachers in 2021/2022.
- 2.9 thousand schools (1.5 thousand School at general industrial education, 1052 Schools at trade education, 301 School at agricultural education in 2021/2022.
- •834.1 thousand Pupils at General commercial education 92.2 %, Hospitality education to 70.9 thousand Pupils by 7.8 % of total commercial education in 2021/2022.

#### Special education

- 44.4 thousand Pupils by 0.2 % of total educational stage in 2021 / 2022.
- 9.8 thousand teachers at by 0.9 % in 2021 / 2022.
- 1.1 thousand schools at education. whereas there is no Azhar special education in 2021/2022

#### Al Qaraat:

- 11.0 thousand Pupils at Al-Azhar in 2021/2022.
- 0.9 thousand teachers at Al-Azhar by 0.1 % in 2021/2022.
- 118 total number of Azhar Institute for the academic year 2021/2022 while there is no Qaraat at general education.

#### Total general:

- 27.3 Million Pupils at pre-university education stages 2021/2022, versus 26.3 Million Pupils 2020/2021, an increase by 3.7 % Of total students.
- 1.14 Million teachers in 2021/2022, versus 1.17 Million teachers 2020/2021, a decrease by 2.7 % of total teachers.
- 70.1 thousand schools and public Azhar institutes 2021/2022, compared to 68.9 thousand schools and public Azhar institute 2020/2021, an increase by 1.8 %.
