2.8 % An increase in the number of pre-university Pupils for the academic year 2022 / 2023


Central Agency for public Mobilization and statistics (CAPMAS) issued today /12/2023 "Annual Bulletin of pre –university education for the academic year 2022/2023 "

Main indicators include:

Pre-primary:

- 1.4 Million Pupils by 5.1 % of total educational stages (1.2 Million Pupils by 4.9 % at general education, 188.1 thousand Pupils by 7.4 % at Azhar education) in 2022/2023.
- 63.2 thousand teachers (59.4 thousand teachers by 6.2 % at general education, 3.8 thousand teachers by 2.7 % at Azhar education) in 2022/2023.
- 13.1 thousand schools at education, 1.8 thousand Azhar institute education for the academic year 2022/2023.

Relative distribution the number of students enrolled in pre-university education(General - Azhar) for the academic year 2022/2023



Primary:

- 15.1 Million Pupils at general by 53.9 % of total education stages (13.7 Million Pupils by 53.7 % at general education, 1.4 Million Pupils by 56.1 % Azhar Education) of total educational stages in 2022/2023.
- 485.5 thousand teachers by 419.3 thousand teachers at general education by 43.7 % ,66.2 thousand teachers by 47.1 % Azhar Education) in 2022/2023.
- 19.9 thousand schools, 3.7 thousand Azhar institutes in 2022/2023.
- 0.2% of primary school dropout rate in 2022/2023 compared to 0.2% in 2021/2022.
- 96.8% transition rate from primary to middle school in 2022/2023.

Community education:

- 141.5 thousand Pupils at (one class) by 0.5 % of total educational stages in 2022/2023.
- 7.7 thousand teachers by 0.7 % of total educational stages in 2022/2023.
- 4.9 thousand schools (one class) of education for 2022/2023 there is no community education at Al-Azhar.

Preparatory:

- 6.5 Million Pupils by 23.3 % of total educational stages (6.0 Million Pupils by 23.6 % at general education, 505.2 thousand Pupils by 19.9 % at Azhar Education) in 2022/2023
- 275.2 thousand teachers (238.4 thousand teachers at general education by 24.9%, 36.9 thousand teachers by 26.2 % at Azhar Education) in 2022/2023.
- 13.7 thousand schools at education 3.6 thousand Azhar institutes in 2022/2023.

- 1.7 % dropout rate in primary school 2022/2023, compared to 0.9% in 2021/2022
- 37.6 % Transition rate transition from primary to preparatory stage in 2022/2023.

Secondary:

- 2.5 Million Pupils by 9.0 % of total educational stages (2.1 Million Pupils by 8.3 % at education, 402.2 thousand Pupils by 15.9 % at Azhar education) in 2022/2023.
- 128.9 thousand teachers at education (96.2 thousand teachers at education by 10.0%, 32.7 thousand teachers by 23.3% at Azhar education 2022/2023.
- 4.5 thousand schools at general education, 2.4 thousand Azhar institutes in 2022/2023.

Technical Secondary:

- 2.3 Million Pupils by 8.0% of total educational stage (1.1 Million Pupils by 46.9 % Industrial education, 926.0 thousand Pupils by 41.1 % commercial education (General/hotel), 269.5 thousand Pupils by 12.0 % Agricultural education) of total technical secondary education in 2022/2023.
- 128.4 thousand teachers (82.4 thousand teachers at industrial education by 64.2%, 35.5 thousand teachers at commercial education (General Hotel) by 27.7 %, 10.4 thousand teachers at agricultural education by 8.1%) of total technical education teachers in 2022/2023.
- 3.1 thousand schools (1690 Schools at general industrial education, 1099 Schools at commercial education (General Hotel), 325 Schools at agricultural education in 2022/2023.
- 853.5 thousand Pupils at General commercial education by 92.2 %, Hotel education to 72.5 thousand Pupils by 7.8 % of total commercial education in 2022/2023.

Special education

- 46.4 thousand Pupils by 0.2 % of total educational stage in 2022 / 2023.
- 9.5 thousand teachers by 1 % at general educational in 2022 / 2023.
- 1.2 thousand schools at education. whereas there is no Azhar special education in 2022/2023

Al Qaraat:

- 16.6 thousand Pupils at Al-Azhar in 2022/2023.
- 0.8 thousand teachers at Al-Azhar by 0.6 % of Azhar educational in 2022/2023.
- 123 total number of Azhar Institute for the academic year 2022/2023 while there is no Qaraat at general education.

Total general:

- 28.0 Million Pupils at pre-university education stages 2022/2023, compared to 37.3 Million Pupils 2020/2021, an increase by 2.8 % Of total students.
- 1.10 Million teachers in 2022/2023, compared to 1.14 Million teachers 2021/2022, a decrease by 3.8 % of total teachers.
- 71.8 thousand schools and public Azhar institutes 2022/2023, compared to 70.1 thousand schools and public Azhar institute 2021/2022, an increase by 2.4 %.
