1.7 % An increase in the number of pre-university Pupils for the academic year 2023 / 2024

Central Agency for public Mobilization and statistics (CAPMAS) issued today /12/2024 "Annual Bulletin of pre –university education for the academic year 2023/2024 "

Main indicators include:


Total general:

- 28.5 million Pupils at pre-university education stages 2023/2024, compared to 28.0 million Pupils 2022/2023, an increase by 1.7 % Of total students.
- 1.05 million teachers in 2023/2024, compared to 1.10 million teachers 2022/2023, a decrease by 4% of total teachers.
- 73.2 thousand schools and public Azhar institutes 2023/2024, compared to 71.8 thousand schools and public Azhar institute 2022/2023, an increase by 2 %.

I: Pre-primary:

- 1.5 million Pupils by 5.2 % of total educational stages (1.3 million Pupils by 4.9 % at general education, 210.5 thousand Pupils by 7.4 % at Azhar education) in 2023/2024.
- 63.5 thousand teachers (59.8 thousand teachers by 6.5
 % at general education, 3.7 thousand teachers by 2.8
 % at Azhar education) in 2023/2024.
- 13.3 thousand schools at education, 1.9 thousand Azhar institute education for the academic year 2023/2024.

II: Primary:

- 15.2 million Pupils at general by 53.4 % of total education stages (13.6 million Pupils by 53.1 % at general education, 1.6 million Pupils by 56.3 % Azhar Education) of total educational stages in 2023/2024.
- 469.4 thousand teachers by 406.3 thousand teachers at general education by 44% ,63.2 thousand teachers by 47.8 % Azhar Education) in 2023/2024.
- 20.1 thousand schools, 3.7 thousand Azhar institutes in 2023/2024.
- 0.3% of primary school dropout rate in 2023/2024 compared to 0.2% in 2022/2023.
- 97.8% transition rate from primary to middle school in 2023/2024.

III: Community education:

• 142.4 thousand Pupils at (one class) by 0.5 % of total educational stages in 2023/2024.

- 7.8 thousand teachers by 0.7 % of total educational stages in 2023/2024.
- 4.8 thousand schools (one class) of education for 2023/2024 there is no community education at Al-Azhar.

IV: Preparatory:

- 6.7 million Pupils by 23.5 % of total educational stages (6.1 Million Pupils by 23.9 % at general education, 570.7 thousand Pupils by 20% at Azhar Education) in 2023/2024
- 265thousand teachers (230.1 thousand teachers at general education by 24.9%, 34.9 thousand teachers by 26.4 % at Azhar Education) in 2023/2024.
- 14 thousand schools at education 3.6 thousand Azhar institutes in 2023/2024.
- 0.7 % dropout rate in primary school 2023/2024, compared to 1.7% in 2022/2023.
- 43.9 % Transition rate transition from primary to preparatory stage in 2023/2024.

V: Secondary:

- 2.7 million Pupils by 9.4 % of total educational stages (2.2 million Pupils by 8.7 % at education, 440 thousand Pupils by 15.4 % at Azhar education) in 2023/2024.
- 121.1 thousand teachers at education (91.4 thousand teachers at education by 9.9%, 29.7 thousand teachers by 22.4% at Azhar education 2023/2024.
- 4.8 thousand schools at general education, 2.4 thousand Azhar institutes in 2023/2024.

VI: Technical Secondary:

- 2.2 million Pupils by 7.7% of total educational stage (1 million Pupils by 46.4 % Industrial education, 933.9 thousand Pupils by 42.5 % commercial education (General/ hotel), 244.6 thousand Pupils by 11.1 % Agricultural education) of total technical secondary education in 2023/2024.
- 118 thousand teachers (67.8 thousand teachers at industrial education by 65.1%, 32.1 thousand teachers at commercial education (General Hotel) by 27.2 %, 9.1 thousand teachers at agricultural education by 7.7%) of total technical education teachers in 2023/2024.
- 3.4 thousand schools (1789 Schools at general industrial education, 1256 Schools at commercial education (General Hotel), 341 Schools at agricultural education in 2023/2024.
- 861.5 thousand Pupils at General commercial education by 92.2 %, Hotel education to 72.5 thousand Pupils by 7.8 % of total commercial education in 2023/2024.

VII: Special education

- 47 thousand Pupils by 0.2 % of total educational stage in 2023 / 2024.
- 9.2 thousand teachers by 0.9 % at general educational in 2023 / 2024.
- 1.2 thousand schools at education. whereas there is no Azhar special education in 2023/2024.

VIII: Al Qaraat:

- 24.7 thousand Pupils at Al-Azhar by 0.1 % of Azhar educational in 2023/2024.
- 747 teachers at Al-Azhar by 0.1 % of Azhar educational in 2023/2024.
- 125 total number of Azhar Institute for the academic year 2023/2024 while there is no Qaraat at general education.
