- 7,41 million vehicles by £1,7% in urban governorates, 7,11 million vehicle by 79,4% in lower governorates, \,\tau million vehicle by 77,5% in upper governorates, 177,77 thousand vehicles by 7,5% in frontier governorates) of the total vehicles compared to 6.6 million vehicles in 31/12/2012, an increase 6.6%.
- •The Cairo Governorate came in ranked first in terms of number of vehicles by Y, Y million vehicles by 19,0%, followed by Giza by number A & V, A T thousand vehicles by 17,.%, and Alexandria ranked third
