Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) has issued on $//(7 \cdot 1) \xi$, the Annual Statistical Bulletin of The actual production, deactivated energy and inventory of full production at industrial activities level, in the public sector / public business (sector establishment) $(7 \cdot 1) (7 \cdot 1)$.

The most important indicators are as follows:

Actual production

• The total value of actual production reached $177, \pm$ billion pounds in 7.17/7.17 compared to 117, 7 billion pounds in 7.11/7.17, an increase of 1.7 billion pounds at a rate of 9,1%.

• Coke and petroleum products as the highest percentage reached ^{1,A,1} % followed by the food industry by ^{V,9%} of the total.
