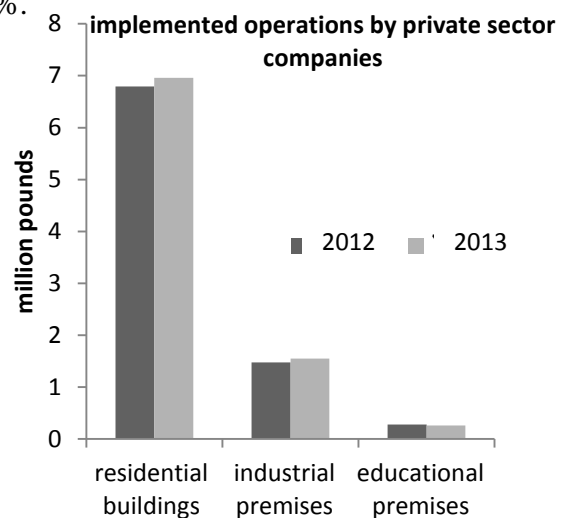
10.8 % increase in the value of the implemented operations in building and construction field by private sector companies in 2013

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics has issued on / / 2014, the Annual Statistical Bulletin of building and construction for private sector companies in 2013.

The current stable economic situation of the country leads increase in the performance of building and construction field, especially private sector enterprises. The total value of the implemented operation by private sector companies reached 25.7 billion pounds in 2013 versus 23.2 billion pounds for 2012, an increase of 10.8%.

The most important indicators are as follows:

- The total value of residential buildings amounted to 6957 million pounds in 2013 compared to 6795 million pounds in 2012, an increase of 2.4%
- The total value of implemented industrial premises reached 1550 million pounds in 2013 versus 1476 million pounds in 2012, an increase of 5.0%.
- The total value of educational premises reached 261 million pounds in 2013 versus 281 million pounds in 2012, a decrease of 7.3%.



- The total value of implemented water stations and networks by private sector companies reached 309 million pounds in 2013 versus 535 million pounds in 2012, an decrease of 42.2%.
- The total value of electricity stations and networks reached 546 million pounds in 2013, versus 530 million pounds in 2012, a increase of 3.0%.
- The total value of implemented sewage plants and sewer systems reached 1228 million pounds in 2013 versus 1434 million pounds in 2012, a decrease of 14.3%.
