Total amount of goods transported by river reached 7.6 million tons in 2014

Central Agency for public Mobilization and statistics (CAPMAS) issued Today / / 2015 annual bulletin of goods and passengers transported in the river transport sector in 2014.


The most important indicators are as follows:

■ Number of river units

- The total river units which transport goods and passengers reached 968 unit in 2014 including (756 unit for companies that work for others ,212 units for companies that work for its own).
- The total number of river units in (government, public / public Business) sectors reached 554 units by 57.2% from total number of river units in companies that work for others and companies that work for its own.
- The total number of river units in (private sector) reached 414 unit by 42.8% from total number of river units in companies that work for others.

• the total amount of goods transported by the river

- The total amount of goods transported by river reached 7.6 million tons in 2014 including (6.9 million tons in companies that work for others by 90.6 %, 0.7 million tons in companies that work for its own by 9.4 % from total amount of goods transported by river.
- The total amount of goods transported by river in (government, public / public Business) sectors reached 1.7 million tons by 22.6 % from total amount of goods transported by river, 5.9 million tons in (private sector) by 77.4 % in 2014.



- Mining and quarrying goods came at first rank as it reached 4.6 million tons from total amount of goods transported by river in 2014 by 60.5 %, The most important goods transported was stone which reached 3.8 million tons by 81.8 % of total mining and quarrying goods transported by river.
- The Industrial goods came at the second rank as it reached 2.3 million tons from total amount of goods transported by river in 2014 by 30.1 %, The most important transported goods was cars which reached 1.8 million tons by 79.6% of total industrial goods transported by river.

- Agricultural goods came at third rank as it reached 0.7 million tons from total amount of goods transported by river in 2014 by 9.2 %, The most important transported goods was Fish which reached 0.6 million tons by 80.5 % followed by sugar cane which reached 61 thousand tons by 8.6 % followed by wheat which reached 38 thousand tons by 5.4 % of total Agricultural goods transported by river.
- The total amount of the other goods reached 11 thousand tons from total amount of goods transported by river in 2014 by 0.2 %

Number of passengers transported by the river

• The total number of passengers transported by river reached 24.3 million passengers in 2014, including 9.1 million passengers in (government, public / public Business), 15.2 million passengers in (private sector).
