# Central Agency for Public Mobilization And Statistics

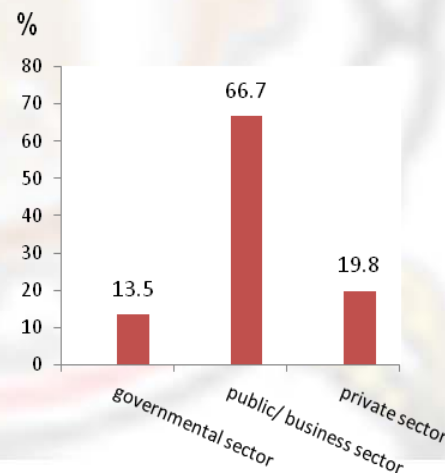
### 0.6% decrease in the number of work injury cases in 2014

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) issued today / / 2015 the "Annual Bulletin of work injury statistics in the governmental sector enterprises, public / public business and the private sectors (50 workers or more) in 2014", the most important statistical indicators are as follows: The total number of work injury cases reached 16902 cases in 2014 compare to 16996 cases in 2013, a decrease of 94 case by 0.6 % distributed as follows:

### 66.7 % of the injuries in the public / public business sectors

The number of work injury cases in the governmental sector reached 2283 cases by 13.5%, in the public sector / public business 11280 cases by 66.7%, in the private sector ( 50 workers or more ) reached 3339 cases which represent 19.8% of the total number of cases. □

### 89.5 % of work injuries are for males

The number of work injury cases reached 15132 cases by 89.5 % for males, while it reached for females 1770 cases by 10.5 % of the total number of cases.

### **30.7% of the injuries in Cairo governorate**

Cairo Governorate recorded the largest number of work injury cases which reached 5188 case by 30.7 % of the total number of cases, followed by Alexandria Governorate which reached 3681 case by 21.8%, while Matrouh Governorate recorded the lowest number of work injury cases which reached 6 cases by 0.04 % of the total number of cases.□

### **34.9 % of the injuries are in factories workers, machine operators and production workers**

Factory workers, machine operators and production workers recorded the largest number of work injury cases, it reached 5901 cases by 34.9%, followed by technicians and associate professionals which reached 4681 cases that represents 27.7 %, while the lowest number of work injury cases was for occupational skilled agricultural and fishery workers that reached 22 cases by 0.1 % of the total number of cases.□

### **62.9% of the injuries in manufacturing activity**

Manufacturing activity recorded the largest number of work injury cases as it reached 10636 cases by 62.9%, followed by transport and storage activity which reached 2234 cases by 13.2 % of the total number of cases, while the lowest number of work injury cases was in the amusement, creation and arts activities which reached 9 cases by 0.1 % of the total number of cases .

### **84.1 % of injuries occurred at workplace**

The total number of cases that occurred in workplace reached 14222 cases by 84.1 % of the total number of work injury cases .The other work injury cases occurred either from or to work place which reached 2680 cases by 15.9% of total number of cases.
