15.7% decrease in the number of Egyptians who have obtained approval to migrate abroad in 2013

CAPMAS issued in / / 2014 the annual bulletin for Egyptians who have obtained approval to migrate abroad in 2013; the most important statistical indicators in the bulletin are as follows :

-The number of Egyptian immigrants who have obtained approval to migrate and those who have acquired immigrant status reached 430 immigrants (main and accompanied) in 2013 compared to 510 immigrants in 2012, a decrease of 15.7% versus 537 immigrant (main and accompanied) 2011 a decrease of 19.8% ,in 2010 reached 617 immigrant (main and accompanied)a decrease of 30.3%.

Canada was the first in the number of Egyptians who have obtained approval to migrate abroad by 38.6%

-The number of Egyptians who have received approval to migrate abroad reached 382 main immigrants by 88.8 % , 84 accompanied immigrants by 11.2 % of the total number.

-Canada came in the first rank of the number of Egyptians who obtained approval of migration abroad where immigrants numbered 166 by 38.6 % of the total number.

-The number Egyptians males who have obtained approval of migration abroad of reached 374 immigrants by 87% , Female 56 immigrant by 13% of the total.

-The number of degree-level qualifications (BA – Bachelor-licence) of the Egyptians who obtained the approval to migrate abroad reached 231 by 56.5% of the total number of main and accompanied immigrants.

-Age group of (30-34) ranked first in the number of Egyptian who obtained approval to migrate abroad as it reached 94 immigrants by 21.9% followed by ago group of (35-39) a number of 68 immigrant by 20% of the total.

56 % of the total number of Egyptians who have acquired foreign nationality was from the group of European countries

- The number of Egyptians who have acquired foreign citizenship reached 1704 immigrants in 2013 compared to 1902 immigrants in 2012, a decrease of 10.4 % European countries group come in the first rank , where numbered 954 immigrants by 56% , Followed by American States group of 409 immigrants by 24%, then Arabian States 285 of immigrants by 16.7% of the total .
