41.4% decrease in the number of foreign employees in the governmental sector

Central Agency for Public Mobilization & Statistics issued on / / 2015 "The annual bulletin of foreign employees in governmental sector & public / public business sector in 2014".

The most important statistical indicators are as follow:

- The total number of foreign employees in these sectors reached 560 foreigners in 2014 compare to 956 foreigners in 2013 decrease of 41.4% due to the decrease in the number of foreign employees especially in Petroleum Sector after 30 June revolution.

44.6% of the total foreign employees are from European countries

- Foreigners from European countries represent the largest number which reached 250 foreigners by 44.6%, followed by Asian countries (non-Arab), 124 foreigners by 22.1%, while Oceania countries represent the lowest numbers which reached 18 foreigners only by 3.2%.
- Foreigners that have a university degree represents the largest number which reached 312 foreigners by 55.7%, followed by less than university degree 158 foreigners by 28.2%.
- Specialists (Scientific Professions owners) represents the largest number which reached 314 foreigners by 56.1%, followed by technicians and aides 103 foreigners by 18.4%, while clerks represents the lowest numbers reaching 17 foreigners by 3% of the total foreigners number.

52.3 of the total foreign employees in Public Authorities Sector

Foreign employees in public Authorities represents the largest number, which reached 293 foreigners by 52.3% of The total number of foreign employees in governmental sector & public / public business sector in 2014 (most of them works in Radio and Television union & Egyptian Mineral Resources Authority), followed by foreign employees in public / public business sectors with 165 foreigners by 29.5% (most of them works in Metallurgical Industries holding Company).
