12.1% decrease in the number of foreigners working in the private and investment sector in Egypt in 2013

CAPMAS issued on / / "The Annual bulletin of Foreigners working in the private and investment sector in Egypt in 2013 " and the most important statistical indicators are as follow:

 The total number of foreigners employees in the private and investment sector reached 14699 foreigners from different nationalities in 2013 compared to 16713 foreigners in 2012 adecrease of 12.1%.

34.9% arrivals from Asian countries (non Arabic)

Foreign arrivals, from Asian countries (non Arabic) represent the largest number which reached 5136 foreigners by 34.9%, followed by European countries that reached 4145 foreigners by 28.2%, then Arabic countries that reached 4061 foreigners by 27.6%, while the African countries (non Arabic) represent the lowest number that reached 170 foreigners by 1.2% of the total in 2013.

27.6% Legislators, senior officials and managers

Legislators, senior officials and managers came in the first rank in terms of number of foreigners employees in these professions which reached 4053 foreigner by 27.6%, followed by foreign technicians and associate professionals that reached 3335 foreigners by 22.7% then crafts and related trades workers that reached 2250 foreigners by 15.3%, then Professionals that reached 1836 foreigners by 12.5% of the total in 2013. 15.3% percentage of Palestinians working in the private and investment sector

Palestine came in the first rank in terms of number of foreigners employees in the private and investment sector which reached 2247 foreigners by 15.5%, followed by Bangladesh which reached 1906 foreigners by 13%, then India which reached 1313 foreigners by 8.9%, then England which reached 765 foreigners by 5.2% of the total in 2013.

46.4% working licenses issued by the labour force Directorates

- The labour force Directorates represents the first rank in terms of working licenses issue where the number of working licenses issue reached 6820 licenses by 46.4%, followed by investment office which reached 5007 licenses by 34.1%, then Corporate office which reached 1549 licenses by 10.5%, then Petroleum office which reached 1323 licenses by 9% of the total in 2013.
