9.1% a decrease in the number of Egyptians who get approval for Emigration abroad and Egyptians who acquired other nationality in 2019

Central agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics issued today : / / 2020 Annual Bulletin of the Egyptians obtained, approval " to migrate abroad and Egyptians with another nationality in 2019" the most important statistical indicators are as follows: - Number of Egyptian emigrants who have obtained approval to migrate and those who have acquired emigrant status reached 350 emigrants (main and accompanied) in 2019 compared to 385 emigrants in 2018, a decrease of 9.1%.



Italia was ranked first in number of Immigrants who obtained approval to migrate abroad by 37.1% in 2019

- Number of Immigrants who obtained approval to migrate abroad reached 297 main emigrants by 84.9% · 53 accompanied emigrants by 15.1 % of the total number.

- Italia was ranked the first rank in number of Immigrants who obtained approval of migration abroad where emigrants was 130 by 37.1 % of the total number.

- Number of Egyptian migrants who have obtained approval of immigration and who acquired the status of emigrant abroad reched 301 immigrants, By 86.0%, females are 49, 14.0% of the total.

-Number of graduates with bachelor's degree (BA) from Egyptians who obtained the approval of emigration and who acquired status of emigrant abroad reached 147 migrants with 43.2 % of the total number of main and accompanied emigrants in educational age cohorts (10 years and over) of 340 immigrants.

- Immigrants in the age group (40 - 44 years) are the first in terms of number of Egyptians who have obtained approval of emigration and who acquired the status of emigrant abroad. The Number of migrants reached 64 migrants by 18.3% of total.

2.9% a decrease in Number of immigrants who acquired foreign nationalities in 2019

- The number of Immigrants who have acquired foreign citizenship reached Egyptian 2616 in 2019, compared to 2694 Egyptians in 2018, with increase of 2.9 %. (1329 Egyptians obtained permission of nationalization while retaining the Egyptian nationality by 50.8%, 1287 Egyptians obtained permission to naturalize, with no Egyptian nationality being retained at a rate of 49.2%) of the total.
