# Decline by 3 % in the Number of Live Births in 2020

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics issued today / 12 / 2021 the Annual Bulletin of Births and Deaths Statistics 2020. The most important indicators are as follows:

# 2.235 million Live Birth 2020

• Number of live births reached 2235326 births in 2020, compared to 2304832 births in 2019, decline by 3 %, while Crude Birth Rate reached 22.2 per thousand in 2020 compared to 23.3 per thousand in 2019, decline by 1.1 per thousand.



• Total Fertility Rate is the number of children a woman would have in her reproductive life. Total Fertility Rate reached 2.9 children per woman in 2020 compared to 3.0 children per woman in 2019.

### **Stability of Sex Ratio at Birth (105 Male per 100 Female)**

- Sex ratio at birth reached 105 Male /100 Female in 2020, the same as it was in 2019.
- Male births reached **1143611** in 2020, compared to **1179033** in 2019, decline by **3** %.
- Number of female births reached 1091715 in 2020, compared to 1125799 in 2019, decline by 3 %.

#### Decline by 7.9 % in Urban Births in 2020

- Urban births reached 1142864 in 2020, compared to 1240549 in 2019, decline by 7.9 %.
- Rural births reached 1092462 in 2020, compared to 1064283 in 2019, increase by 2.6 %.
- Urban Crude Birth Rate reached **26.5** per thousand in 2020 compared to 29.3 per thousand in 2019, decline by 2.8 per thousand midyear population.
- Rural Crude Birth Rate reached **19.0** per thousand in 2020 compared to **18.8** per thousand in 2019, increase by 2.8 per thousand midyear population.

# **Cairo Ranked First in Terms of Live Births with 9% Total Live Births**

- Cairo ranked first in terms of births percent distribution with 9% of total births in 2020 compared to 9.2 in 2019, a decline by 0.2 %.
- South Sinai ranked last in terms of births percent distribution with 0.1 % of total births in 2020 as the same as it was in 2019.
- Matrouh, Asyut, Suhag, Qena and Menia recorded the highest Crude Birth Rate in 2020.
- Port-Said , Demietta , Dakahlia , North Sinai, and Kalyoubia recorded the lowest in terms of the Crude Birth rate in 2020 .



### 664.7 thousand Deaths in 2020

Number of deaths reached 664763 in 2020 compared to 570580 in 2019, increase by 16.5 %. Crude Death Rate reached 6.6 per thousand midyear population in 2020 compared to 5.8 per thousand midyear population in 2019, increase by 0.8 per thousand midyear population.



# 54.5 % is the Percentage of Male Deaths

- Male deaths reached 361971 in 2020 compared to 312105 in 2019, increase by 16 %.
- Female deaths reached 302792 in 2020 compared to 258475 in 2019, increase by 17.1 %.
- Percentage of male deaths reached 54.5 % of total deaths in 2020 compared to 54.7 % in 2019.
- Percentage of female deaths reached **45.5** % of total deaths in 2020 compared to **45.3** % in 2019.

#### Decline by 19.8 % in Rural Deaths in 2020

- Urban deaths reached 402175 in 2020 compared to 351475 in 2019, an increase by 14.4 %.
- Rural deaths reached 262588 in 2020 compared to 219105 in 2019, an increase by 19.8 %.
- Urban Crude Death Rate reached 9.3 per thousand midyear population.in 2020 compared to 8.3 per thousand midyear population in 2019
- Rural Crude Death Rate reached 4.6 per thousand midyear population in 2020 compared to 3.9 per thousand midyear population in 2019.

### **Cairo Ranked First in Terms of Deaths with 15.5% Total deaths**

- Cairo ranked first in terms of deaths percent distribution with 15.5 % of total deaths in 2020.
- South Sinai ranked last in terms of deaths percent distribution with 0.1 % of total deaths in 2020 as the same as it was in 2019.
- Cairo, Alexandria ,Gharbia ,Luxor and Aswan recorded the highest Crude Death Rate in 2020.
- North Sinai, Fayoum, Red Sea, Suhag and Menia recorded the lowest in terms of Crude Death Rate in 2020.



#### **Crude Death Rate According to Governorates 2020**

- Number of Infant deaths (less than one year) reached **35197** in 2020 compared to **36173** in 2019, decline by **2.7 %**. Infant Mortality Rate recorded **15.7** per thousand live births in 2020, the same as it was in 2019.
- Number of Under 5 mortality reached 44300 in 2020 compared to 46956 in 2019, decline by 5.7 %. Under 5 Mortality Rate recorded 19.8 per thousand live births in 2020 compared to 20.4 per thousand live births in 2019.
