

The Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics issued today / / 2017 "Annual Bulletin of Foreign Workers in the Public Sector and Public Sector / Public Works in 2016".

The total number of foreign workers in the public sector and the public sector / public works was 889 foreigners (789 males, 88.8%, 100 females, 11.2%) in 2016 compared to 850 foreigners in 2015, a increase of 4.6%.





53.5% of all foreign workers from European countries

 Represent European countries represent the largest number of foreign workers in the public and public sector / public business in 2016, with 53.5% foreign, followed by Asian countries (non-Arab) 151 foreigners by 17%, while African countries (non-Arab) Only 50 foreigners accounted for 5.6%.



- Represent The number of foreigners with a university qualification was the largest with 515 foreigners at 57.9%, followed by those with less than 210 university graduates by 23.6%.
- Represent Professionals (scientific professionals) accounted for the largest number, reaching 535 foreigners by 60.2%, followed by senior officials and managers numbered 190 foreigners by 21.4%, while scribes accounted for the lowest number, with only 12 foreigners representing 1.3% of the total number of foreigners.

49.4% of all foreign workers work in public bodies

 Represent The number of foreign workers in public bodies reached 439 foreigners (49.4%), most of them working in the Radio and Television Union and the Egyptian General Authority for Petroleum, followed by foreign workers in the public sector / public business with 351 foreigners (39.5% Natural).
