8.3% decrease in the number of foreigners working in the private and investment sector in Egypt in 2012

The central agency for mobilization and statistics announced on / / the annual bulletin of foreigners working in the private and investment sector in Egypt in 2013 and the most important statistical indicators of the annual bulletin as follow: The total number of foreigners working in the private and investment sector reached 16713 foreigner from different nationalities in 2012 compared to 18234 foreigner in 2011 with a drop of 8.3%.

32.5% of arrivals from Asian countries (non Arabic)

Foreign arrivals, from Asian countries represent the largest number that reached 5438 foreigner by 32.5%, followed by Arabic countries that reached 4882 foreigner by 29.2%, then European countries that reached to 4709 foreigner by 28.1%, while the African countries (non Arabic) represent the lowest number that reached 161 foreigners by 1 % of the total in 2012.

24.5% of foreign technicians and associate professionals

Foreign technicians and associate professionals came in the first rank in terms of number of foreigners working in these professions which reached 4094 foreigner by 24.5%, followed by legislators, senior officials and managers reached 3928 foreigner by 23.5% then crafts and related trades workers reached 2771 foreigner by 16.6%, then Professionals reached 1996 foreigner by 11.9% of the total in 2012.

19.7% percentage of Palestinians working in the private and investment sector

State of Palestine came in the first rank in terms of number of foreigners working in the private and investment sector which reached 3285 foreigner by 19.7 %, followed by Bangladesh reached 2213 foreigner by 13.2%, then India reached 1340 foreigner by 8%, then England reached 1280 foreigner by 7.7% of the total in 2012.

50.7% working licenses issued by the labour force Directorates

The labour force Directorates represents the first rank in terms of working licenses issue where the number of working licenses issue reached 8480 license by 50.7%, followed by investment office reached 5720 license by 34.2%, then Petroleum office reached 1611 license by 9.7%, then Corporate office reached to 902 license by 5.4% of the total in 2012.
